MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHIEF OF BUREAU

The Department's emphasis on youth work is being carried out through the National Committee of the Department of Education, which was organized on December 26, 1953, in Manila. The Committee is headed by the Secretary of Education and has as its members the heads of the various offices of the Department of Education.

The Committee is currently working on the theme "This Year's Child" and is planning to hold a National Conference on the subject of the child in the Philippines. The Conference will be held in Manila on August 30, 1954, and will be attended by representatives of the various offices of the Department of Education and by representatives of the various churches and organizations in the Philippines.

The Conference will be held at the Department of Education Building, Manila.

The following are the objectives of the Conference:

1. To discuss the current situation of the child in the Philippines.
2. To discuss the role of the child in the development of the nation.
3. To discuss the role of the child in the development of the church.
4. To discuss the role of the child in the development of the community.
5. To discuss the role of the child in the development of the family.



4. The Congress is open to college students taking degree courses, preferably those with experience in youth leadership training projects/activities. A student delegate shall be at least a second-year college student and should be recommended by a school, college, or university head.

5. All schools, colleges, and universities are urged to participate in the Congress. Heads of schools, colleges and universities may recommend not more than ten (10) selected students from each institution to attend the Congress. Deadline for the submission of applications of student delegates is November 30, 1979. Inclosed is a copy of the application form.

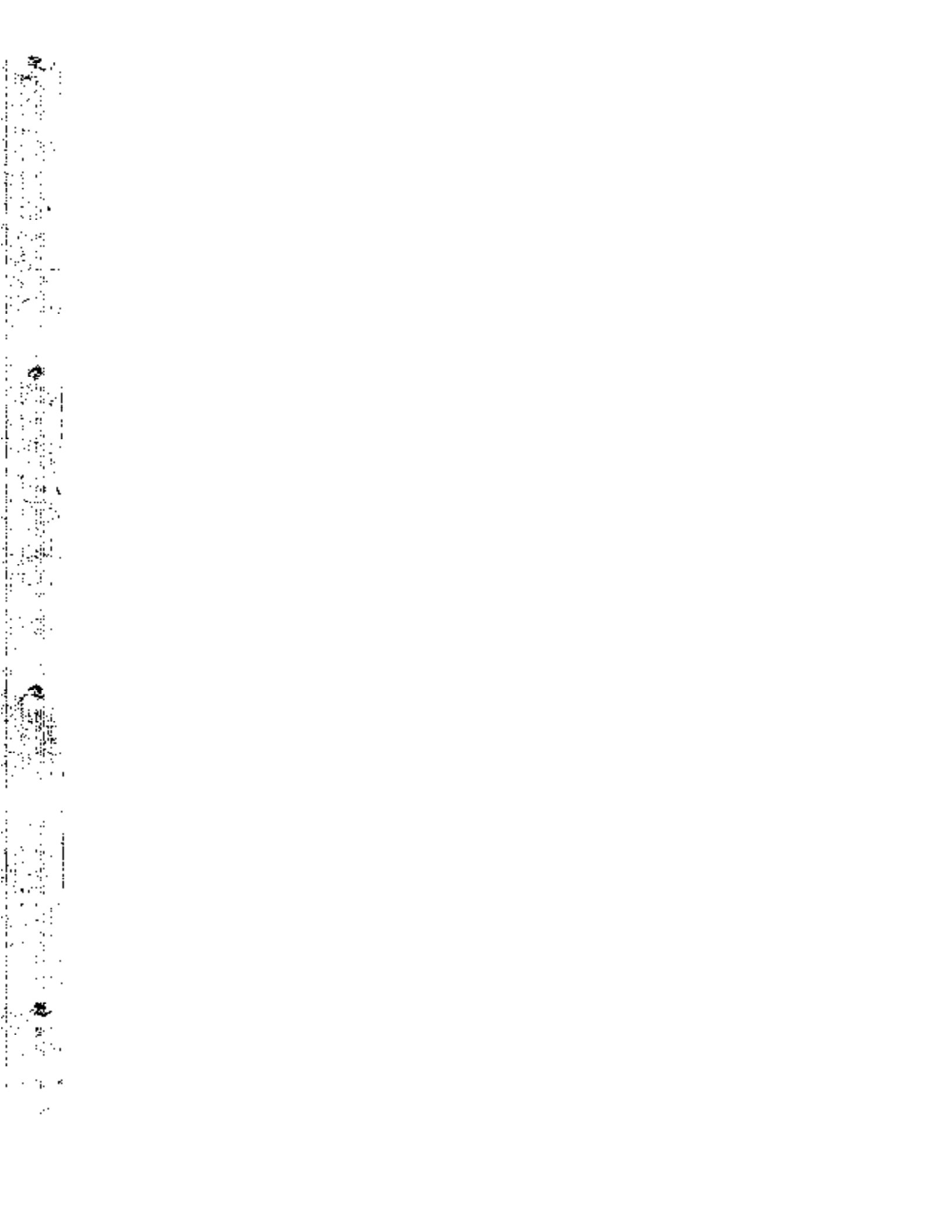
6. Conference fees and expenses for accommodation, transportation, and other items that may be incurred in connection with attendance in the Congress shall be borne by the students or by any private organization.

7. A certificate of attendance signed by the Deputy Director of Education and Culture and the President of the YMCA of Manila will be given to each participant. Time spent for actual civic action work while attending the conference shall be credited as partial fulfillment of YCAP requirements, subject to the provisions of Department Order No. 18, s. 1977, entitled "Guidelines for the Implementation of the Youth Civic Action Program."

8. Student delegates shall submit reports on their participation in the conference which shall include a summary of the discussion, talks, or papers, the materials and handouts, as well as their recommendations.
