1 In observance of this year's birthday anniversary of President Ferdinand E. Marcos, this Office has lined up for September 11, 1979, significant school activities in which the President has shown special interest, to wit:

- a Food production
- b Alay Tunog and nutrition
- c Sports development
- d Bilingual education
- e Home industries
- f Trades and cooperatives promotion and development
- g Energy conservation

2 Accordingly, all schools, colleges, and universities, instead of holding regular classroom sessions, shall undertake actually the aforementioned activities. The organization and implementation of these activities are left to the sound discretion of school heads concerned provided that the implementation be done efficiently and with dignity in keeping with the significance of the day and the purposes for which the Alay sa Pangulo has been conceived. As a general policy, however, each school's participation should be along its special competence or known specialization.

3 To prepare the pupils and students for the celebration thereby internalizing the significance of the day, all classroom activities on September 10, 1979 should cover or touch upon the life of the President, particularly his achievements and plans, programs and projects undertaken or being undertaken to attain the goals of the New
