REGIONAL CONFERENCE ON WATER AWARENESS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
School Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. The curriculum materials developed for the joint MEC-Local Water Utilities Administration Project: WAIER (Water Awareness through Educational Resources) will be tried out this school year starting September. In this connection, an orientation conference for all regional and division staffs involved and tryout teachers (secondary level only) will be held in all regions starting from August 27 to September 8. The orientation will be conducted by two teams, A and B, composed of representatives from MEC and LWUA.

2. For this purpose, it is requested that regional offices make the necessary arrangements for the following:

- a. Selection of the 4 pilot high schools: one private, one vocational, one general, and one barangay high school nearest the regional office as tryout schools.
- b. Immediate notification and attendance of the staff and tryout teachers involved. It is requested that each year level be represented by 6 pilot teachers of the pilot school actually teaching the following subjects:
 - (1) Communication Arts (English)
 - (2) Communication Arts (Filipino)
 - (3) Social Studies
 - (4) Science
 - (5) Mathematics
 - (6) Practical Arts (Home Economics)

3. A local water district representative will coordinate with the regional office with regard to the accommodation of participants and venue for the orientation program.

4. Enclosed are the appendices for reference.

5. Reasonable transportation expenses incident to the attendance of those involved in the orientation conference are chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

6. In accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement between the Ministry of Education and Culture and the National Commission on Higher Education (NCHED) dated January 10, 1976, the following officials shall be entitled to receive the stipend and allowances indicated:
