INTENSIFICATION OF ASSISTANCE TO THE PHILIPPINE CANCER
SOCIETY EDUCATIONAL, MEMBERSHIP AND FUND CAMPAIGN

1. Statistics gathered from various clinics and hospitals show that the prevalence of cancer is increasing every year.
2. The Philippine Cancer Society, a private, civic and non-profit organization which is dedicated to the fight against cancer, is now in the midst of its fund campaign this year in an effort to generate funds for its program of prevention and control of this dreaded disease.
3. In view of its most worthy effort in fighting this disease, the organization deserves the full support of all sectors of our society. For this reason, this Office reiterates its appeal to the teaching and non-teaching personnel, as well as to the parents and the students to give their generous share of donation to help in the pursuit of the Society's program of expanded services, which include the intensification of its educational campaign for cancer awareness, the maintenance of free medical services through its Cancer Divisions in the provinces.
4. As stated in Memorandum No. 37, s. 1979, remittances from each superintendent or school head shall be in check or money order drawn in favor of the Philippine Cancer Society, Inc., and transmitted to the regional director, who in turn, shall transmit the same to this Office, c/o Deputy Minister Narciso Albarracin, Educational Division Campaign Chairman.

5. It is desired that this Memorandum be given wide publicity in all schools and offices.
