THE 1979 NATIONAL MUSIC COMPETITIONS FOR YOUNG ARTISTS

To Bureau Directors
 Regional Directors
 Schools Superintendents

1 Pursuant to Presidential Decree No 1173, the 1979 National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA) will be held at the Cultural Center of the Philippines during the last week of November to coincide with the celebration of National Music Week

2 The objectives of the competitions are the cultivation of high quality music and the promotion and preservation of Philippine music for national development geared toward the discovery and development of musically-talented school children and students. The participants in the various categories will be required to perform one Filipino song by a Filipino composer.

3 This year's competitions will be confined to the following categories: (a) children's choir, (b) youth choir, (c) piano, (d) solo voice, (e) family ensemble, (f) solo instruments, and (g) strings.

4 Regional directors, assisted by their regional and division music supervisors acting as coordinators, are hereby designated heads of the 1979 NAMCYA regional committees, to oversee the contests in their respective areas. Mr. Mindanao B. Razon of this Office has been designated National Coordinator.

5 Transportation and allowances incident to the supervisors' assignments may be charged against the funds of the regional offices or the divisions concerned subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing requirements.

6 Inclosed is a copy of the 1979 NAMCYA Handbook containing the list of the regional secretariats, the prizes to be awarded, the timetable, the schedule of different contests, the rules and regulations covering the competitions, and other pertinent information.

7 It is requested that the widest publicity be given to the contents of this Memorandum:

PROCLAMATION NO. 1173

**DECLARING THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 26 TO DECEMBER 2, 1978 AS
NATIONAL MUSIC WEEK FOR YOUNG ARTISTS**

WHEREAS Filipino music is the expression of the soul of the Nation

WHEREAS in recognition of the Filipino's innate love for music a fitting celebration to encourage young artists to excel in music composition and performance is most opportune and

WHEREAS there is an imperative need to preserve, develop and promote Philippine music as an art and as a handmaid of cultural development

NOW THEREFORE I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the period from November 26 to December 2, 1978 and henceforth every last week of November each year as **NATIONAL MUSIC WEEK FOR YOUNG ARTISTS**. I urge all citizens of this country as well as all associations and organizations to declare this week appropriately to encourage Filipinos to appreciate Filipino music and make it form part of their cultural life.

In order to insure the successful celebration of this week throughout the Philippines, a Special National Committee is hereby formed to take charge of the arrangements for its celebration, composed of the following:

National Music Competitions for Young Artists
Young Artists Foundation of the Philippines**

The National Music Competitions for Young Artists is an annual national project which aims to discover young potential artists in the field of choral singing piano chamber music family ensemble and indigenous instruments. It is an activity which highlights the celebration of the National Music Week for Young Artists held every last week of November as per Presidential Proclamation No. 1173 dated August 7, 1973. This project is under the sponsorship of the CCP for the First Lady's Young Artists Foundation of the Philippines with the aim of preserving, developing and promoting Philippine music as an art and as a handmaid of national development.

In 1972 the Cultural Center of the Philippines in association with the Chorale Philippines launched the First National Children's Choir Competition with contestants coming from Greater Manila and adjoining provinces. The competition expanded into different contest categories the following year. The solo instrument piano and family ensemble competitions were held for the first time in 1973. To meet the musical needs of our youth the youth choir competitions were held for the first time in 1975 with Greater Manila choirs participating.

In 1977 a third category C for the Piano competition was added for Bachelor of Music degree holders to encourage the graduate students in piano to maintain a high standard of performance. For the competitions in 1978 category D was added. This year the Solo Voice category has been opened.

To insure the success of this national project four prestigious organizations assist the CCP in the implementation of the rules and regulations set by the Executive Board of the NAMCYA. They are the Chorale Philippines, Piano Teachers Guild of the Philippines, Philippine Society for Music Education and Jeunesses Musicales of the Philippines. Regional Secretariats are formed in the thirteen regions to ensure participation all over the country.

The benefactor for the 1979 competitions is Hardis Group.

This handbook covers the rules and regulations for all the contest divisions.

- 5 Only one (1) choir may qualify to represent a region for the final competitions.
- 6 A registration fee of P30.00 to regional secretariat shall accompany the application of each competing choir.
- 7 Participating choirs must come for Regional competition in attires without school or any other identifying marks.
- 8 All songs shall be memorized. No choreography or body movement is allowed.
- 9 No soloists allowed.
- 10 Conductors, accompanist can perform only with one choir.
- 11 Accompaniment is limited to piano. Songs may be sung a cappella.
