SCIENCE CLUB MONTH CELEBRATION

1. The Science Foundation of the Philippines is sponsoring a nationwide Science Club Month celebration in September 1979, which will start with the "Lakad Agos" participation from Regions III, IV (NCR), and IV-A. The Month will culminate with the holding of the National Symposium on Environmental Matching in Batas, Ilocos Norte on September 26-30.

2. The theme of the celebration is "Youth Leadership Development Through Science Clubs in Support of National Development Goals (Science Club Contribution to the International Year of the Child Celebration)."

3. The celebration gives due recognition to the Youth who have been instrumental in the education of our people in the countryside on science and technology. Its singular significance lies in its implication and impact on the overall efforts of the nation towards national development through science and technology. At the same time, the event is a fitting offering for the celebration of the International Year of the Child emphasizing the role of today's youth in insuring a better environment for the children of the future.

4. In view of the appreciated importance of the event, this Office enjoins all schools in the divisions to give full support and cooperation in the month-long activities which are outlined in the inclosed program of activities.

5. Expenses incident to the participation of science club members/advisers may be paid from local school funds subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing regulations. This applies to all activities on Public Understanding of Science, Technology and Environment (PUSTE).

6. It is requested that this Memorandum be disseminated to all schools, colleges and universities.
