16TH ANNUAL WORLDWIDE UN INFORMATION TEST

To: Bureau Directors

1. The United Schools International (USI) will hold the 16th Annual Worldwide UN Information Test on October 24, 1979 in celebration of the United Nations Day. The test is open to all secondary school students in any country, the Philippines included.
2. The purpose of the test is to make students aware of the aims and objectives, programs and activities of the United Nations and its specialized agencies.
3. The test paper will contain questions on the Charter, activities, aims and objectives of the United Nations and the specialized agencies. To pass the test, which is of two hours duration, the participant should obtain 40 per cent marks. Those who pass the test will be awarded certificates. The candidates getting the first 10 positions in the test will be awarded special merit certificates and their photos will be printed in the Annual Report of the USI.
4. The admission fee for each candidate is equivalent to half US Dollar (\$3.50) which is to be collected by the head of the school of the participating student. The school participating in the test may retain 30 per cent of the collected admission fee for its incidental expenses. The test paper will be sent to participating schools well in advance.
5. The answer books will be examined by a teacher designated by the school head concerned and only the marksheets, which will be supplied by the secretary, are to be sent to: The Secretary, United Schools International, USC House 6, Special Institutional Area, New Delhi - 110067 (INDIA). Previous test papers are available on request free of charge. A book entitled "UN in Schools" at a price of 50 cents is recommended as a help book for students preparing for these tests.

6. The USI is also inviting secondary schools to become corporate members by paying the annual subscription fee of US \$5.00. Inclosed is a corporate membership form which may be filled and mailed immediately by any school interested to the following address:

7. Considering the importance of the above-mentioned activities in furthering the cause of the United Nations and developing international understanding among all students in the world, it is enjoined that as many students as are interested should be encouraged to participate in the test.
