SIXTH NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION  
OF VOCATIONAL ARTS SUPERVISORS INCORPORATED

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Association of Practical Arts Supervisors (PAPAS), the National MATTA Secretariat and the Ministry of Education and Culture, Region VI will sponsor a work-conference for Practical Arts and Vocational education supervisors to be held in the Division of Texas City, City of Texas on November 14-16, 1979.
2. The following are the objectives of the work-conference:
  - a. To make more relevant the activities of industrial arts, practical arts and agricultural arts to the national job creation program;
  - b. To make specific plans of action in inculcating desirable work ethics among pupils and students through workshop activities;
  - c. To encourage the production of quality and marketable semi-industrial articles utilizing available indigenous raw materials of the country; and
  - d. To up-date MATTA commitment in the implementation of MATTA programs.
3. Participants are the regional and division agricultural and industrial arts and vocational supervisors of state colleges and universities and private schools.
4. Delegates should bring along with them samples of finished products made out of the raw materials found in their communities and appropriate handtools to be used for demonstration during the workshop.







5. Delegates should be in Texas City in the afternoon of November 13, 1979 for registration. Travel expenses, per diem and a registration fee of \$200 per delegate shall be charged against local NCLC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations on personal funds.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be disseminated immediately.
