AUTHORIZING THE MORAL RE-ARMAMENT FOUNDATION TO CONDUCT
AN EDUCATIONAL MEMBERSHIP AND FUND CAMPAIGN

To Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1 Inclosed is a copy of Proclamation No 1894 of His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, dated August 16, 1979, authorizing the Moral Re-Armament Foundation of the Philippines to conduct an educational, membership and fund campaign from May 1 to December 31, 1979

2 The Foundation is a non-sectarian, non-profit, and non-stock educational and cultural organization whose objective is to carry out a program for the moral rehabilitation of our people, especially our youth, giving special emphasis to the four moral standards of absolute honesty, purity, unselfishness, and love, in order to effectively build a New Society as fully enunciated in Department Memorandum No 53, s 1977

3 The Proclamation specifically "enjoins all residents, business firms, civic, educational, religious, and government institutions to support this humanitarian movement," and provides that "donations in connection with this campaign are deductible in full for income tax purposes as per Presidential Decree No 507 "

4 This Office endorses this campaign. In the collection of donations or contributions as allowed in the Proclamation, however, there shall be no compulsion or duress that violates the voluntary character of the contribution. This Office is preparing an Order restricting all contributions to only those that are purely voluntary

5 It is requested, in this connection that the campaign be conducted on a regional basis with each regional director assuming responsibility for the conduct of the campaign. Remittances from

each superintendent or school head shall be in check or money order drawn in favor of the Moral Re-Armament Foundation of the Philippines and transmitted to the regional director who in turn shall transmit the same to this Office, c/o Deputy Minister Narciso Albarracin, MRA Educational Division Campaign Chairman.

6 It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought to the attention of all concerned for appropriate implementation.

PROCLAMATION NO 1884

AUTHORIZING THE MORAL RE-ARMAMENT FOUNDATION OF THE
PHILIPPINES TO CONDUCT AN EDUCATIONAL, MEMBERSHIP
AND FUND CAMPAIGN FROM MAY 1
TO DECEMBER 31, 1979

WHEREAS, the promotion of the moral values of our people and the development of our youth into well-disciplined and useful citizens are the vital concern of our Government

WHEREAS, projects for the achievement of this end and the provision of proper facilities for conducting such projects should be encouraged and

WHEREAS, the Moral Re-Armament Foundation of the Philippines is carrying out a program for the moral rehabilitation of our people, especially our youth, giving special emphasis to the four moral standards of absolute honesty, purity, unselfishness, and love, to build a new society

NOW, THEREFORE I, FERDINAND F. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby authorize the Moral Re-Armament Foundation of the Philippines to conduct an educational, membership and fund campaign from May 1 to December 31, 1979. I enjoin all residents, business firms, civic, educational, religious, and government institutions to support this humanitarian movement.

Donations in connection with this campaign are deductible in full for income tax purposes, as per Presidential Decree No 507.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed
