PROMOTING POPULATION EDUCATION IN PRIVATE SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Population Center Foundation (PCF) in cooperation with the Population Education Program of the Ministry of Education and Culture (MEC) has launched a project that shall promote population education in private schools. The project aims to encourage greater participation of private schools in imparting population learning and greater adoption of effective techniques in integrating population education in their schools.
2. A component of the project is a research survey to be undertaken in October 1979. In this connection, interviews will be conducted with high school principals and teachers on the extent, manner and difficulties of introducing population education in private schools. The data gathered will be transformed into cases and a state-of-the-art paper and will be communicated to the sectors concerned (administrators, principals, teachers and associations) through a problem-solving conference in 1980.
3. High school principals and teachers are enjoined to extend their utmost cooperation and assistance to this project.
4. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to those concerned is desired.
