1979 HEALTH EDUCATION WEEK

1. Conformably to Presidential Proclamation No. 255, Health Education Week this year will be observed from October 7 to 13, at the PNC Health Education Auditorium, Ayala Blvd., Manila. The theme of the celebration is "Health Education: Focus on the Youth."

2. In this connection, it is desired that all schools, in collaboration with the barangay leaders throughout the country, plan and implement appropriate and meaningful activities for the week geared towards the theme. There is an apparent need to awaken the youth as well as the adults to the vital health problems confronting our country today and how they may be able to help solve the problems individually and collectively.

3. The officers and members of the Health Education Association of the Philippines (HEAP), health education supervisors, school physicians and nurses in both public and private schools are enjoined to attend the celebration.

4. Since the theme is focused on the youth, it is requested that public schools in Greater Manila send two student representatives (third and fourth year students) to attend the activities prepared for the youth scheduled on October 8 and 9 at the Philamlife and PNC Health Education Auditorium respectively.

5. Attendance will be on official time but at their own personal expense.

6. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is requested.
