ANNUAL ANTI-TB EDUCATIONAL AND PUBLIC CAMPAIGN THROUGH
THE SALE OF ANTI-TUBERCULOSIS SEALS

1. The Philippine Tuberculosis Society, Inc., in line with its efforts to control tuberculosis, is undertaking its Anti-TB Seals Campaign to help finance its services to our countrymen afflicted with the disease.

2. This Office endorses this campaign and invites attention to Presidential Proclamation No. 842 dated April 26, 1979, enclosed with MEC Memorandum No. 45, s. 1979, calling upon "all citizens and residents of the Philippines regardless of race or creed to support actively and give generously of their time and resources to the Anti-TB cause, so as to hasten the control of this debilitating disease, minimize human suffering among the afflicted, in promote national strength and prosperity through a healthy citizenry free from the dangers of the disease."

3. Anti-tuberculosis seals will be sold to the schools, colleges and universities in Metro Manila and in the provinces. The seals may also be ordered from the National Office of the Philippine Tuberculosis Society Inc., Quizon Institutes Compound, Quezon City, and from the different branches of the Society in the provinces.

4. In the sale of these seals, however, there shall be no compulsion or force that violates the voluntary character of the contributions.

5. The cooperation of all schools is hereby requested.
