INTERAL COORDINATION WITH OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES IN THE  
LOCALITY IN CONNECTION WITH THE ADMINISTRATION  
OF THE 1979 NCEE

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The success of the administration of the National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) simultaneously throughout the country on November 11, 1979, will largely depend upon the concerted cooperation of all concerned in the implementation of the program. Regional directors and schools division superintendents are tasked to provide the needed leadership to insure the success of the NCEE project, code named "SIGLA."
2. A meeting with the representatives of the different agencies mentioned in the enclosed Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 1163 dated August 30, 1979, was held at the National Educational Testing Center (NETC), Manila, regarding the problems of transportation facilities in the different regions of the country. The conferees pledged full support to the project.
3. The sectoral representatives request that each NCE regional director and/or schools division superintendent concerned should present their problems regarding transportation facilities to the directors or officers in charge of the supporting agencies. They should likewise identify specific areas or places where their services are needed.
4. A report on the coordination made should be submitted to NEDC, Arriolaeros, S., Manila, not later than October 15, 1979 so that appropriate action can be taken for its implementation.
5. Compliance with this requirement is desired.

LETTER OF THE PRESIDENT TO SECRETARY RIOSECO

RE: EXAMINATIONS FOR THE 1978 NATIONWIDE

URGENT REQUIREMENT CONCERNING THE 1978 NATIONAL EXAMINATIONS OF THE  
ASSOCIATED HIGH SCHOOL AND THE COLLEGE COUNCIL, THE PHILIPPINE  
SCHOOL BOARD, THE ASSOCIATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS WITH THE PHILIPPINES  
AND THE 1978 NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL EXAMINATION (NHEX).

WHEREAS, the National Secondary Education Center (NSEC), Ministry of  
Education and Culture (MEdC), is charged with the duty of administering the  
National Secondary Examinations (NSE) required of all high school gradu-  
ates seeking admission to postsecondary course programs to pass said exam-  
ination, as prioritized under Circular No. 14 dated March 9, 1973;

WHEREAS, the NHEX is scheduled to be given on November 11, 1978 in about  
1,300 examination centers throughout the country to more than half-a-million  
examinees, a job so vast considering the geographic conditions of the Philip-  
pines;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of National Defense (MND), the Armed Forces of  
the Philippines (AFP), the National Intelligence and Security Authority (NISA),  
the Integrated National Police (INP), and the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA),  
are hereby tasked to extend maximum support and assistance to the NSE, MNEC,  
to ensure full security and smooth administration of the 1978 NHEX all over the  
country.

In a similar vein, the Ministry of Local Government and Community Develop-  
ment (MLGCD), the Philippine National Railways (PNR), the Philippine Airlines  
(PAL), the Ministry of Public Works (MPW), the Ministry of Public Works  
the National Land Transportation (NLT), and the National Railways Authority  
(NRA) are likewise directed to issue and to act effectively as may be deemed ne-  
cessary for the smooth implementation of the herein-mentioned examination.

The Ministry of Public Information (MPI), the National Media Production  
Center (NMP), and the Bureau of Broadcast Stations (BBS), are likewise en-  
joined to extend maximum support and assistance relative to the dissemination  
of essential information pertaining to the holding of the examination and the  
utilization of communication facilities throughout the country, respectively.
