SCHEDULE OF REGIONAL AND NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCES
OF THE FFF AND FAAP ORGANIZATIONS

1. For the school year 1979-1980 the Future Farmers of the Philippines, (FFF), Inc. and the Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines (FAAP), Inc. shall hold their 3-day Regional Work-conference within the months of November and December 1979, whereas the National Work Conference is tentatively set for February 12-16, 1980 at the Pampanga Agricultural College, Negalgang, Pampanga. Two copies of the regional proceedings should be submitted two weeks after the regional conference to enable the National Secretariat to consolidate for the forthcoming national conference.
2. The dates of the regional Work-conference as agreed upon during the National Board Meeting held in Manila on July 20-24, 1979 is found in Inclosure No. 1 and should be followed as much as possible.
3. Suggested activities for the regional as well as the national level is found in Inclosure No. 2.
4. All activities should be in consonance with the theme for this school year which is "Gearing the activities of the FFF-FAAP towards the Job Creation Program."
5. Expenses incident to the holding of the regional and national work-conferences should be charged against the following funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing requirements:

- CONFERENCE FUND
- a. Student delegates - chapter and personal funds.
- b. Administrators, advisors and other school personnel with special assignment in the conference - local school funds.
- c. Regional adult officials - NEC regional funds.
- d. NMOC-NSM officials and staff - BSR funds.
- e. It is desired that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity for the information and guidance of all concerned.

SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES FOR THE FPI AND FAIR REGIONS
AND VILLAGE COMPETITIONS

- I. Parliamentary procedures at public speaking competition should be emphasized.
- II. Competitive skills should include:
 - A. For FAFF Contests:
 1. Cooking contest should be conducted in the regional level. The best from the region will compete in the national level.
 2. Recipes should utilize use of common local ingredients.
 3. How soon can a girl use a coconut as an ingredient in a main dish?
 4. All contestants in the regional level should submit a written procedure of their winning recipe in the regional level.
 5. All recipes will be compiled and issued in brochure at cost.
 6. Similarly creativity of girls should be explored for handiwork contest. All directions for making handicraft articles will be compiled and issued in the field.
 - B. For FPI Competitive activities -
 1. Contest in public speaking is a must for FPI both regional and national. It should be extemporaneous and original.
 2. Skills in identification of tools, chefs, fertilizers, seeds, judging layers, castrating goats and pigs and other similar activities should be competitive and with grand prizes.
 3. Skills in rope splicing, plowing with native plow, making straight furrows and driving the tractor may be done if facilities are available.
 4. Stake orchard, bidding, grafting, macrotting and other horticultural skills should be competitive.
 5. Each delegate (FPI) is a competitor and only entitled to participate in one special skills contest, hence all delegates to the national convention should be ready for this.
