REGIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP IN CEBUANAS (RHST-III)

To: Bureau Directors

1. The third phase of a three-year program entitled "Strengthening the Secondary Schools Guidance Program" will be conducted by the Ministry of Education and Culture through the Bureau of Secondary Education in cooperation with the Karl Diefberg Gesellschaft Philippines, Inc.

2. The 3-day live-in seminar-workshop will be held in six (6) regional centers. The theme is "Functional Secondary School Guidance Program for Youth Development."

3. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are as follows:

- a. To refine the roles and functions of all personnel involved in guidance.
- b. To identify and utilize workable approaches and instruments in guidance for various services.
- c. To plan programs and strategies for the improvement of existing validated services.
- d. To enhance the skills and expertise as well as perception of counselor and staff personnel.

5. The participants to Phases I and II held at Baguio City  
on May 3-7, 1977 trip, the Gaethe House, on Baguio's 13-7, 1978, re-  
spectively, will continue these regional seminar-workshops and will  
be facilitators for the workshops. The guidance supervisor of host  
region is the chairman of the seminar-workshop.

6. Participants to the seminar-workshop are the following:

a. From the regional offices - General Education  
Supervisor II in charge of guidance in the  
secondary level.

b. From the provincial/city division:

(1) Division supervisor in charge of guidance in  
the secondary level.

(2) Three secondary school guidance counselors from  
each ornithological division representing public, (in-  
stitutional and vocational) and private schools.

The number of participants to each seminar-workshop center should  
not exceed 100, except in Center II.

7. A registration fee of P100 will be charged each participant.  
This will cover cost of handouts and other miscellaneous  
expenses. Expenses of participants in connection with their attendance  
to said Seminar-Workshops are chargeable against regional/  
division/local school funds subject to the usual accounting and  
auditing rules and regulations.

8. The Carl Duisenberg Gesellschaft Philippines will provide  
for the services and transportation of the consultants from Manila  
to the different centers and for other materials needed for the  
seminar-workshops.







9. Division delegated to this seminar-workshop must:
- be permanent guidance counsellors
  - have the highest number of units obtained in guidance and counseling and psychology.
  - have the highest rating of performance in research in the mentioned field.
10. Participants are requested to bring with them their existing guidance programs, sample test materials, homework activities, sample guidance forms and other materials they may have to use for the workshop.
11. Enclosed is the tentative schedule of activities for the seminar-workshop.
12. It is requested that 5 copies of the proceedings be furnished the Bureau of Secondary Education.
13. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated immediately for the information and guidance of all concerned.
