EXERCISING MILITARY LEADERSHIP BY SCHOOL OFFICIALS
DURING THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE 1979 NCEE

and Universities

1. The National College Entrance Examination is the most massive testing program of the Ministry of Education and Culture and as such, every year the Ministry relies heavily for support on the school personnel in the field to make this program a success.

2. To preclude the occurrence of any anomalies/outrageous incidents during the administration of the test to be administered on November 11, attention is hereby invited to Sub-paragraph 4, Section 2 of the Inclosure to MEM Order No. 56, s. 1979 entitled "Updated Policies on the National College Entrance Examination," to wit:

"All teachers/officials guilty of negligence, backsliding, and other infractions in the performance of their official duties pertinent to the administration of the NCEE, such as tolerating cheating among examinees, are liable under P.D. No. 6 for conduct prejudicial to the best interests of the public and consequently, may be administratively charged."

3. The enthusiasm and honesty inspired by the example of school officials during the administration of the test can go far in generating the right attitude towards maintaining the integrity and confidentiality of the test.

4. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately disseminated.
