15th NATIONAL RIZAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors

Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. The Order of the Knights of Rizal, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will hold its 15th National Rizal Youth Leadership Institute on December 26-30, at the Apex Hall, Junior Area, Teachers Camp, Baguio City, in commemoration of the 83rd death anniversary of Dr. Jose Rizal. The over-all theme will be "Rizal and Moral Values."

2. This annual leadership institute sponsored by the Order of the Knights of Rizal calls for the involvement of the students so that their off-campus education in the areas of character building, citizenship training, personal discipline and progressive leadership could be enriched. Another purpose of the institute is to appraise and evaluate the ideals and teachings of Rizal which find relevance in our contemporary society.

3. Six (6) sub-topics will be discussed, namely:

- Rizal and Moral Values in the Home
- Rizal and Moral Values in Public Service
- Rizal and Moral Values in the School
- Rizal and Moral Values in the Community
- Rizal and Moral Values in Media
- Rizal: Values in Boy and Girl Relationship







4. Distinguished persons or officials invited to speak at the seminar will include Justice Minister Ricardo Puno; Public Information Minister Francisco Tased; Education and Culture Deputy Minister Narciso Albarracín; Maryknoll College President Dr. Lourdes Quisumbing; FIC President Dr. Leticia Perez de Guzman; UB President Dr. Conrado Aquino; and Maunabo and Philippine Movement President Leon Marcos X. Ferras.

5. All schools, colleges and universities, public and private, are requested to encourage their students to attend the seminar. The amount of \$200 will be charged each delegate to cover transportation expenses from Manila to Baguio and back, board and lodging, convention portfolio, reading materials, etc., and may be shouldered by the delegates themselves, their private sponsors, or in the case of delegates from private schools which are able and willing. DOI No. 805 prohibits the use of government funds for attendance in conventions, etc. conducted by private groups.
