SECOND LEVEL SI SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON PREVENTIVE  
DRUG EDUCATION FOR TRAINERS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. The UP-MEC National Drug Education Program will conduct the Second Level SI Training Program on Preventive Drug Education for trainers at the College of Education, University of the Philippines, Roxas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City, from November 6 to 25, 1979.
2. The overall objective of the seminar-workshop is to provide intensive training on drug education to trainers who are expected to work as a team in setting up and/or strengthening existing preventive drug education at the elementary and secondary school levels and colleges of education in their respective provinces and cities.
3. Specifically, the seminar-workshop aims to develop among the participants competencies which will enable them to:
  - a. develop keener sensitivity to the problems of drug abuse,
  - b. increase awareness of socio-psych-cultural factors influencing drug abuse,
  - c. improve, upgrade and develop curricular materials for drug education integrated with Health education and other allied areas of study;
  - d. acquire innovative strategies for teaching/learning and evaluating drug education;
  - e. acquire scientific skills and techniques for identifying, handling, and referring suspected cases of drug abuse;
  - f. develop skills in coordinating and cooperating with private, civic and government agencies concerned with education, regulation and control of drug abuse; and
  - g. develop training programs for preventive drug education at the elementary and secondary schools and teacher education colleges.







4. The trainers who will undergo this Second Level II Training Program on Preventive Drug Education are expected to work as a team in planning and conducting the Level III Drug Education Training Program for selected elementary and high school teachers in their respective provinces or cities. The selected teachers who will undergo the Level III Drug Education Training Programs are expected to conduct the Level IV Drug Education Training Program with the assistance from the teachers in their respective schools. Level III and IV Training Programs are to be financed from local funds.

5. The team of trainers will be composed of the following:

- a. One (1) School Physician
- b. One (1) Health Education Supervisor
- c. One (1) Guidance Counselor
- d. One (1) Elementary or High School Teacher, preferably teaching health education
- e. One (1) Teacher from the Teacher Training Institution, preferably one teaching health education in the pre-service program

6. The participants to this training program will come from the following provincial school and city divisions:

- a. Pangasinan
- b. Nueva Vizcaya
- c. Pasiganga
- d. Quezon
- e. Manila
- f. Quezon City
- g. Caloocan City
- h. Pampanga
- i. Albay
- j. Bulacan

7. The teachers in the team will come from the 21 teacher education institutions some of whom participated in the First National Advanced Level Workshop for Teacher Educators held at the College of Education, University of the Philippines, last July 1977 and teacher education institution from the recently re-organized region IV.

8. The participation by these institutions/academe in the forthcoming seminar-workshop in November 1979 will further strengthen their capabilities to provide educational leadership in their respective divisions.

9. The institutions invited to send teachers to participate in this seminar-workshop are the following:

10. The names of the participants should be sent directly to the Office of the Dean, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City, as on before October 29, 1979.

11. The team from each province/city is expected to prepare a brief report based on the outline below. It is suggested that the health education supervisor will convene the team and provide leadership in the preparation of the report.

- a. Status of drug abuse problem in the province or city
- b. Causes of drug abuse
- c. What is being done to prevent and control drug abuse
  - (1) Agencies actively involved
  - (2) Problems of law enforcement and other agencies in combating influx of drugs
- d. Preventive drug education program
  - (1) Elementary and secondary schools
  - (2) Teacher education colleges
    - (a) pre-service
    - (b) in-service
  - (3) Community
  - (4) Problems and issues encountered

The report should be sent to the Dean, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City or as before October 31, 1979.

12. The participants are requested to bring with them instructional materials, visual materials, and other pertinent materials which they have been using in preventive drug education.







13. Travel expenses to Guatemala and back to the Civilization Center per diem of \$25/day for 21 days will be charged against the funds of the project which is being supported by the Dangerous Drugs Board subject to the usual accounting and audit procedures.

14. Although this is not a live-in seminar-workshop, the participants who may wish to live in campus should inform the Penn College of Education, U.P., if they wish to make a reservation at the Benitez Memorial Center, Magasaway Avenue, which charges \$30/day for lodgings only.

15. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
