NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH UTILIZATION FOR INSTRUCTIONAL SYSTEMS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

1. The first live-in workshop on instructional systems utilizing multi-media learning packages for continuing education of teachers will be held at the Baguio Vacation Normal School on December 10-14, 1979 under the joint sponsorship of the RVMS of the National Research and Development Center for Teacher Education and the Education Communication Office of the ECPIATF. The program content is given in the enclosure.

2. This workshop is designed to disseminate first-phase results of on-going pilot studies in four centers namely: Baguio Vacation Normal School, and the divisions of Panacan, Leyte, and Maguindanao and to derive implications for planning, curriculum development, research and evaluation.

3. At the end of the workshop, the participants should be able to:

- a. identify results of pilot studies on Continuing Education of Teachers of ECPIATF and draw implications for use by project implementors, curriculum developers, researchers and evaluators of continuing education of teachers programs;
- b. develop guidelines for curriculum development, media planning and production, transmission utilization, research and evaluation of projects using multi-media learning packages for the continuing education of teachers;

c. Exchange ideas and experiences on program implementation utilizing multi-media learning packages for continuing education of teachers;

d. publish the above-mentioned guidelines for use of those involved in planning and implementation of programs for continuing education of teachers.

4. The participants shall come from the different offices of the Ministry of Education and Culture as herein provided:

a. ECO-EDPITAF staff and field operations personnel of the divisions of Pangasinan, Leyte and Maguindanao.

b. BNNS-NRPCTE personnel involved in CET pilot try-out project at the Baguio Vacation Normal School, Baguio City

c. One representative from each of the following:

- (1) Bureau of Higher Education
- (2) Bureau of Secondary Education
- (3) Bureau of Elementary Education
- (4) Thirteen (13) NEC Regional Offices
- (5) Population Education Program Unit
- (6) National Educational Testing Center
- (7) Office of Non-Formal Education
- (8) Office of Planning Service
- (9) Information and Publication Service
- (10) Institute of National Language
- (11) National YCAP Coordinating Center
- (12) School Health and Nutrition Center
- (13) National Research and Development Center for Teacher Education

5. All travel expenses of the ECO-EDPITAF staff will be charged against EDPITAF funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing requirements. Expenses of the ECO-EDPITAF field operations personnel of Pangasinan, Leyte and Maguindanao divisions will be charged against the grants of EDPITAF in the implementation of the ECO project.

6. Participants other than POC-CDEMF staff and field operations personnel will be given transportation expenses to and from their official stations and daily allowance of ₦10 chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Board and lodging will be charged against the funds of the PVM.

7. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought immediately to the attention of all concerned.
