1. The Children's Museum and Library, Inc. (CMLI), under its leadership-training and character-building program, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture announces the following projects, namely: 1) selection of A-1 children; 2) selection of model pupils/students in the primary, intermediate and secondary levels and out-of-school youth (8 to 20 years) enrolled in adult education classes; and 3) the CMLI National Honor Society of Secondary Students.
2. Inclosed are detailed information and pertinent forms related to the aforesaid projects.
3. Results and lists of the A-1 children and model pupils/students should be submitted not later than December 14, 1979 to the Children's Museum and Library, Inc., East Avenue, Quezon City, P.O. Box 1610, Manila.
4. It is suggested that medals and certificates be presented to the selected children/youth during the celebration of Children's and Youth Achievement Week from February 24 to March 1, 1980 or during the respective school's Recognition Day.

5. Superintendents are requested to be the chairman of the committee in their respective divisions and that community and civic leaders, parents and barangay members be involved as members of the local committee.

6. It is requested that information regarding the projects of the C-ELI be given wide publicity.



- II. Methodology: Public and Dependent Schools

III. SELECTION OF MODEL BOYS/ GIRLS

1. Each school should form the committee for selection of model boy/girls, at least one boy and one girl in each level. Preference be given for such level as there is such pupils or students either the original list given. If it suggested that there be a separate committee for each level.

2. A school offering two primary courses shall submit a minimum of one model boy and one model girl. The same applies to the case of a school offering only the intermediate course. A school offering complete primary, intermediate and secondary courses shall submit a minimum of 5 model boys and 5 model girls. Or a minimum total of 12 model youth.

3. A school offering training and other special courses should submit one model boy (5 to 25 years) and one model girl (5 to 25 years) or one model boy and one model girl.

4. Each school is requested to submit the name of the model boy/girls in each level, school level/ student selected.

5. Names and photographs should (from the school authorities) of model pupils/ students should be submitted to:


