POPULATION AND FAMILY PLANNING WEEK

1. The Population and Family Planning Week this year will be held from November 18 to 24. The theme for the week is "Ang Bata ay May Karapatan sa Mgaandang Kinalabagang." The celebration aims to emphasize a child's right to a bright future which has better chances of achievement through the responsible planning of one's family for family welfare.
2. The focal point of the celebration is the Recognition Ceremony honoring the outstanding metropolitan family planning workers on November 24.
3. All schools are enjoined to undertake appropriate activities to make this Week meaningful and memorable by focusing lessons on population and family planning education, conducting poster and essay contests, holding parades, programs and symposiums, and by undertaking public information activities aligned with this year's theme.
