1979-1980 NATIONAL SCHOOL TRAFFIC SAFETY POSTER CONTEST

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
School Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Motor Association (PMA) jointly with the Ministry of Education and Culture (MEC), the Constabulary Highway Patrol Group (CHPG), the Integrated National Police (INP), and the Bureau of Land Transportation (BLT), will conduct its 15th National School Traffic Safety Poster Contest, the objectives of which are to inculcate traffic safety consciousness and obedience to traffic rules and regulations among pupils and students.

2. The contest which started on October 15, 1979 and will end on March 25, 1980, is open to all pupils and students of elementary and secondary schools, both public and private. It will be conducted on the regional and national levels. Posters may either be in English or in Filipino in any traffic slogan. Some suggestive slogans are listed in the enclosed contest rules.

3. All entries in each region shall be sent in time to reach the superintendent of schools not later than January 15, 1980. All such entries shall then be collected by CHPG and/or INP Traffic Teams and delivered to the MEC Regional Director not later than February 1, 1980.

4. The MEC Regional Director is Chairman of the Regional Contest Committee whose members are the following: BLT Regional Director, CHPG Regional Commander, and INP Regional Commander/Director. The Regional Contest Committee shall designate the regional panel of judges to select the following winners:

three (3) from the primary, three (3) from the intermediate, and three (3) from the secondary level. All winning entries in the regional contests shall be collected by CEFG and/or IEP Traffic Teams from the MEC Regional Directors to be delivered or air-mailed in time to reach the EMA Secretariat, 4071 U. Haggayay Boulevard, P.O. Box 999, Manila not later than March 10, 1980. Postal expenses shall be reimbursed by EMA.

5. It is requested that MEC regional directors coordinate with school superintendents, as well as their counterparts from the BLD, CEFG, and IEP, to give the contest the widest publicity to insure the participation of all elementary and secondary schools.
