THE AGRICULTURAL LIBRARIANS ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES
(ALAP) NATIONWIDE EDUCATIONAL AND FUND CAMPAIGN

1. Included in Proclamation No. 1921 of His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, dated October 15, 1979, authorizing the Agricultural Librarians Association of the Philippines (ALAP) to conduct a nationwide educational and fund campaign during the period from September 15, 1979 to February 28, 1980.
2. The ALAP, a private organization which promotes agricultural library services, is embarked on a project called "MISOLAR PARA SA AKLATANG AGRICULTURAL" which aims to support deserving high school graduates pursuing careers in library science, information science and development communication to provide adequate manpower for the profession.
3. The Proclamation specifically calls for "all citizens and residents of the Philippines to give generously of their means and participate in this laudable endeavor."
4. In view of the fact that the Proclamation allows solicitation of contribution from government officials and employees, including school authorities and teachers and considering that such donations are 100% deductible from the donor's income and gift tax returns, this Office hereby endorses this campaign.

5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.

PROCLAMATION NO. 1921

AUTHORIZING THE AGRICULTURAL LIBRARIES ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES TO CONDUCT AN EDUCATIONAL AND FUND CAMPAIGN DURING THE PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 15, 1979 TO FEBRUARY 28, 1980.

WHEREAS, the development of agricultural science and technology has brought about material and economic progress to the country;

WHEREAS, agricultural librarians and librarians play a vital role in the transfer of technology from the textual materials to the users;

WHEREAS, there is a need for more professionally-trained agricultural librarians, information scientists and documentalists to service the research and information requirements of agricultural scientists and researchers for effective technology transfer; and

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Libraries Association of the Philippines (ALAP) has embarked on a project called "ISKOLAR PARA SA AKLATANG AGRIKULTURAL" which aims to support deserving high school graduates pursuing careers in library science, information science and development communication to provide adequate manpower for the profession.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby authorize the Agricultural Libraries Association of the Philippines to conduct an educational and fund campaign during the period from September 15, 1979 to February 28, 1980.

I call upon all citizens and residents of the Philippines to give generously of their means and participate in this laudable endeavor. I also authorize government officials and employees, including school authorities and teachers, to give it active support and assistance in their respective capacities to insure success of the project.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 30th day of October in the year of Our Lord, Nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.
