COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR THE PRESIDENT FERDINAND L.
MARCOS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR FISHERIES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. For the information of the field, it is hereby announced that an open and competitive examination for the purpose of selecting scholars under the President Ferdinand L. Marcos Scholarship Program for Fisheries will be conducted on January 15, 1980 in 13 regional testing centers to be designated by the DFC regional directors. The examination is for 2-1/2 hours and will include test items in the Sciences (Biology, Chemistry and Physics), Mathematics (Applied Arithmetic, Algebra and Geometry), English (Grammar and Reading Comprehension), and Basic Fisheries. It will be administered in each region by the FEM Scholarship Program Secretariat, assisted by a maximum of 5 proctors designated by the provincial/city schools superintendent of the division where the examination will be conducted.
2. The results of this examination and the list of fishery schools and colleges where the successful examinees may enrol as FEM scholars will be announced in March 1980.
3. The FEM Scholarship Program for Fisheries was operationalized under Special Order No. 201 of the Ministry of Natural Resources dated August 23, 1979, pursuant to a Presidential directive on May 25, 1979, during the convention of the Philippine Federation of Fishfarm Producers. It will be initially implemented starting the first semester of the school year 1980-1981, with a maximum of five (5) scholars per region for college studies leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science in Fisheries.
4. A scholar in the undergraduate level (BSF) under this Program will be entitled to: (a) commutable matriculation and other school fees at P500 per semester and P300 per summer session; (b) book

allowance of P600 per semester and P200 per summer session; (c) monthly stipend of P700; (d) contingencies, including emergency and administrative costs of P100 per semester; and (e) thesis support and graduation expenses.

5. High school graduates/graduating students who are certified to by their respective school heads as among the top ten in the graduating class to which they belong, based on their final grades in all required third year and fourth year subjects, in the case of high school graduates or on their final grades in all required third year subjects and ratings during the first and second grading periods in all required fourth year subjects, in the case of those graduating from high school during the school year 1979-1980, are eligible to take the competitive examination for this scholarship program. It is understood that the applicants are Filipino citizens, of good moral standing, physically fit, free from any criminal, civil or administrative liability, and genuinely interested to pursue college studies in fisheries.

6. Applicants for scholarship under this Program should file their application in duplicate on or before December 22, 1979, using the inclosed application form, through the Provincial FEM Scholarship Screening Committee. This Committee shall be composed of the provincial or city school superintendent as Chairman, the Provincial governor as co-Chairman, and the Assemblyman representing the province, the President of the local Mayor's League and the DEAR Provincial Program Officer, as members. Application forms may be obtained from the office of the provincial/city schools superintendent.

7. The provincial/city schools superintendent shall forward the original of the applications of qualified applicants directly to the FEM Scholarship Program Secretariat, Arcadia Bldg., 860 Quezon Avenue, Quezon City, to reach the said Office on or before December 31, 1979. Applicants shall keep the duplicate to be presented for purposes of identification on the day of the examination.

8. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately disseminated and given the widest publicity possible for the guidance of all concerned.
