ANNOUNCING THE 1980 PUP ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

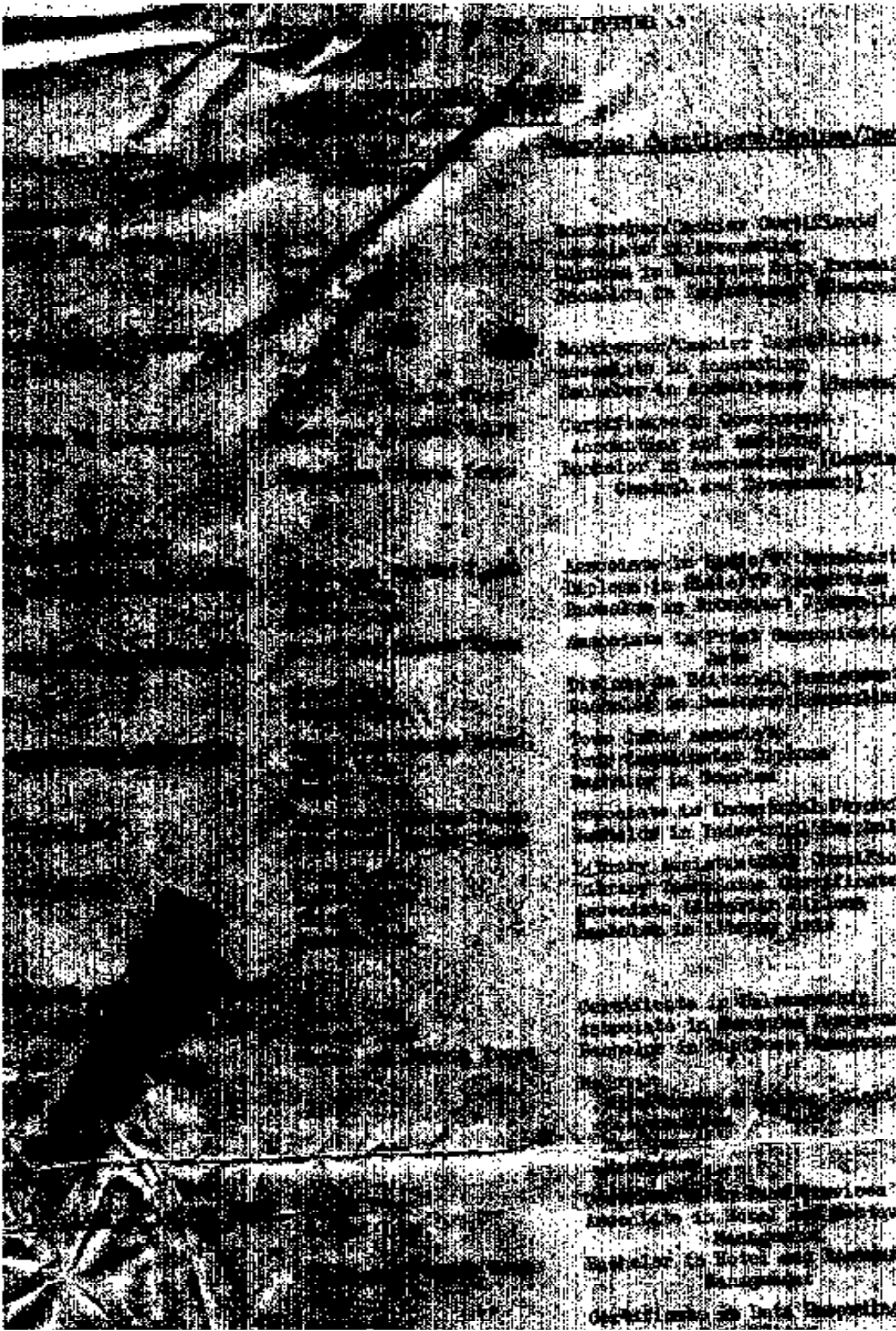

REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE ADMISSION OF STUDENTS

- 1. Review of entrance examinations
- 2. Date of entrance examinations
- 3. Requirements of admission limited to be posted at least 30 days before
- 4. Inventory of successful candidates
- 5. Listing of final list of students qualified for admission at the time
- 6. Inventory of successful candidates
- 7. Inventory of students admitted from outside institutions, particularly medical and dental schools
- 8. Medical examinations

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. All students must have completed the requirements for the Medical College (Qualification) and must have earned a certain amount of credit in a certain period.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES

1. The Registrar in the Public Health Department will be responsible for the necessary information from the various departments.

2. The Registrar will be responsible for the entrance examinations for the various departments.
