PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION FOR GRADUATE EDUCATION
(PAGE) 18TH ANNUAL CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Presidents, Private Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Association for Graduate Education (PAGE), in coordination with the Ministry of Education and Culture and the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAP), will hold its 18th annual convention at the Western Mindanao State University, Zamboanga City, on January 20-23, 1980.

2. Pursuant to national goals, the theme of the convention is: "Graduate Education for Peace and National Unity." The objectives are: (1) To re-align curricular content with the development goals of the country; and (2) To establish a stronger linkage between the educational process and the preservation of the cultural heritage to enhance national consciousness.

3. On account of the timeliness and significance of the theme and objectives of the convention, all heads of the schools concerned are enjoined to send delegates to the convention. The chiefs of higher education divisions in the MEC regional offices, deans of graduate schools, and department chairmen, particularly for business administration, are expected to attend.

4. Attendance is on official time. Expenses incurred by the participants should be charged against local funds in the case of government employees, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. Expenses of participants from private educational institutions should be borne by their respective schools.

5. Immediate dissemination and implementation of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
