INFORMATION CAMPAIGN AND ADMISSION TEST
FOR POST-SECONDARY TECHNICAL COLLEGE

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. For the information of the field, it is hereby announced that the admission test for school year 1980-1981 for entrance to the Manila Technician Institute (MTI), one of the three prototype technician institutes established through Letter of Instructions No. 654, shall be held starting January 19 until February 16, 1980.

2. Admission to MTI is open to all Filipino high school graduates who are 16 to 25 years old, preferably single, physically fit, at least 5 feet tall, and must be proficient in mathematics, physics, and English provided they pass the admission test which will be administered in the following designated testing centers:

3. A maximum of five (5) teachers from each of the designated testing centers may be requested to act as proctors.
4. Various teams from NTE will conduct information campaign among high school graduates prior to scheduled testing dates. Posters and brochures will also be distributed.
5. Application forms may be secured from the office of the principal of the designated testing centers.

6. The courses offered under the 3-year technician program are as follows:

- a. Automotive Technology
- b. Chemical Technology
- c. Civil Technology
- d. Electrical Technology
- e. Electronics Technology
- f. Refrigeration and Airconditioning Technology
- g. Mechanical Technology

7. All concerned are hereby enjoined to widely disseminate the foregoing information and extend necessary support.
