JOINT NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCE OF THE FFP-FAEP  
AND VLP ORGANIZATIONS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
School Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Administrators

1. The Joint National Work-Conference of the Future Farmers of the Philippines (FFP), Inc., Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines (FAEP) Inc., and the Vocational Leaders of the Philippines (VLP - FFP Collegiate chapter) will be held on February 12-15, 1980 at the Pangasinan Agricultural College, Magaling, Pangasinan. The theme of this year's joint conference is, "Gearring the Activities of the FFP-FAEP-VLP Towards the Job Creation Program". The objectives of the conference are found in Enclosure No. 1 to this Memorandum. Also enclosed is the list of officials of the national work-conference.

2. Participants in this work-conference will be:

- a. One student delegate from each organization - FFP, FAEP and VLP (FFP collegiate chapter, FAEP or VLP) - whose school chapter is duly registered in the regional and the national organizations;
- b. Regional chairmen;
- c. Regional executive secretary-treasurers;
- d. Regional coordinators;
- e. Regional FFP and FAEP advisors;
- f. One local chapter advisor from FFP and FAEP and one regional advisor of FFP collegiate chapter;
- g. Chairman, Advisory Council - FFP-FAEP school chapter;
- h. FFP-FAEP national officers (student and adult);
- i. Regional directors/or chiefs of Secondary Education Divisions; and
- j. Regional members to the National Board.







3. Each student delegate will be charged \$25 and adult participants \$30 daily for board. An additional amount of \$4.00 will be charged from each adult for the use of bedding for the duration of the conference.
4. An institutional fee of \$425 will be charged each school to cover the cost of conference supplies and materials, printing of conference proceedings and other necessary expenses for the work-conference.
5. Hand in hand with the joint work-conference of the student delegates, all adult participants will have an executive leadership training program to improve their leadership competencies in the conduct of YFP and BSW activities.
6. Expenses for transportation and board and lodging will be charged against the following sources of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations:
  - a. Student delegates - local YFP-BSW chapter funds
  - b. National student officers - National YFP-BSW funds
  - c. Adult officials - local school funds
  - d. Regional adult officials - YFC regional funds
  - e. YFC-BSW officials and staff - YSE funds
7. Each region is required to bring quality exhibits. All exhibits must be for sale and must be disposed of only on the last day of the convention.
8. All delegates to the convention shall be at the convention site on the morning of February 11, and leave the place after breakfast on February 15, 1960.
9. To implement the policy recommendations as a result of the work-conference, the National Board of Directors will continue holding office up to December 31, 1960. The incoming members of the National Board of Directors elected during the joint national work-conference will assume office beginning January 1, 1961.
10. The program of activities for the work-conference, delegates by school chapter, divisions, school officials with assignments in the work-conference, members of the different working committees and other instructions will be issued in a separate memorandum by the YFP-BSW National Adviser.









11. It is desired that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity for the information and guidance of all concerned.

SECOND NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCE OF THE PFF-PAMP  
AND VLF ORGANIZATIONS

A. Objectives:

1. To prepare a national program of work that is realistic and applicable locally to all school chapters in support of the Job Creation Program.
2. To encourage sharing of leadership, experiences and the acquisition of technological skills through the different competitive activities among members.
3. To intensify competitive technical and academic skills desirable in the promotion of closer cooperation and understanding among members.
4. To recognize, assess and evaluate accomplishments of deserving members and promote them to the different membership degrees with appropriate ceremonies and awards.
5. To upgrade the competencies and managerial skills among adult leaders through leadership training programs for advisers and other adult leaders.

B. Expected outcomes:

1. A national program of work that is applicable and can be undertaken by all school chapters.
2. A set of guidelines for judging the different kinds of skills contest.
3. A list of skills to be used as guide in training members for competitive activities.
4. A set of criteria on the promotion of members to the next higher degree.
5. A manualized instruction to be used by advisers in organizing local school chapters.
