FIRST ANNUAL CONVENTION WORKSHOP OF THE PHILOSOPHY  
OF EDUCATION SOCIETY OF THE PHILIPPINES

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges  
and Universities

1. The Philosophy of Education Society of the Philippines (PESP), in coordination with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will hold its first annual convention at the Benitez Theater, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Quezon City, on February 22-23, 1980.

2. Cognizant of the need for a Filipino philosophy of education, the PESP has adopted the theme: "Philippine Philosophy of Education for the 80s." The objective is: To evolve a more relevant Philippine philosophy of education by:

- a. analyzing issues and problems in Philippine education;
- b. interpreting current purposes, content and methods in education;
- c. reorienting teaching materials to Philippine situations and utilizing ideas of Filipino scholars from other disciplines;
- d. upgrading the teaching of philosophy of education course by improving knowledge of philosophical tools and teaching methods; and
- e. discussing research areas in the field of philosophy of education.

3. All heads of schools offering courses/programs in philosophy of education are enjoined to send delegates to the convention. The chief educational researchers and the supervising educational researchers of the Bureau of Higher Education, chiefs of higher education divi-

sions in the MEC regional offices, deans of graduate schools/teachers colleges and department chairmen of philosophy, are expected to attend. Attendance is on official time.

4. The registration fee of thirty pesos (₱30) includes a convention kit, handouts, and a certificate. Lunch and snacks for two days cost thirty-five pesos (₱35). Expenses incurred by the participants should be charged against local funds in the case of government employees, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. Expenses of participants from private educational institutions should be borne by their respective schools.

5. Immediate dissemination and implementation of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
