1 Two national interagency YCAP consultative conferences shall be conducted one at the Development Academy of the Philippines, Tagaytay City for the Luzon regions on February 28-March 1 the other, at the Ecological Technology Center at Sudlon, Cebu City for the Visayas and Mindanao regions on February 14-16
