FIRST NATIONAL WORKSHOP OF HEADS AND DEANS
OF COLLEGES OF CRIMINOLOGY

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. The First National Conference/Workshop of Heads and Deans of Colleges of Criminology will be conducted under joint auspices of the Ministry of Education and Culture and the National Police Commission at the Mercedes Hotel in Cebu City, on February 4-5, 1980.
2. The objective of the conference/workshop is to prepare and/or formalize a set of recommendations to serve as bases for the issuance of a revised "Rules and Minimum Standards on Criminology Education in the Philippines." Specifically, the conference/workshop will undertake a reassessment of the present components and requirements on Criminology education, especially in terms of:
 - a. curricular objectives and course contents;
 - b. minimum standards on facilities and equipment; and
 - c. linkages for internship/training of students.
3. Participants to this conference/workshop will be limited to heads and deans of Colleges of Criminology.
4. A registration fee of P250 will be charged each participant to cover expenses for supplies, materials, and other necessary expenses for the conference/workshop.

5. Expenses of participants should be borne by their respective schools, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be disseminated immediately to all concerned.
