THE INTEGRATED MEC SCHOLARSHIP FROGRAM 1980-1981

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

- 1. For the information of teachers and other interested school officials, inclosed is a list of scholarship programs sponsored by the Ministry of Education and Culture, in cooperation with some participating institutions.
- 2. The procedure in the selection of scholarship nominees, based on the previous announcement of this Office contained in MEC Memorandum No. 71, s. 1979, is to be followed, i.e., nominees screened by the regional screening committee should have been the output of the nominees screened by the division screening committee. The regional screening committee will in turn send the names of qualified nominees to the MEC Scholarship Committee, Ministry of Education and Culture, Manila, for appropriate action.
- 3. With regard to the scholarship programs at the Marikina Institute of Science and Technology (MIST), the University of the Philippines at Los Baños (UPLB), and the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP), the usual screening procedures should be followed, i.e., the final selection of nominees shall be done by the scholarship committee of the above-named participating institutions with the concurrence of the MEC Scholarship Committee of this Ministry.
- 4. All scholarship programs shall begin in Summer 1980 to enable the grantees to have a summer to summer direction of their scholarship program. The MEC-SIL Scholarship Program is offered during summers only in the Baguic Vacation Normal School, Baguic City.

- For purposes of clarity, the field is bereby informed that MEC Memorandum No. 195, s. 1979, authorizes regional directors to act on all matters pertaining to scholarship programs funded by state colleges and universities such as the MEC-MSU Scholarship Program in Marawi City, MEC-BSC Scholarship Program in Malaybalay, Bukidnon, MEC-CSAT Scholarship Program in Cebu City, MEC-DMMPSCNM Scholarship Program in Cagayan de Oro City, MEC-LIT Scholarship Program in Tacloban City, MEC-PSU Scholarship Program in Bayambang, Pangasinan, and MEC-Ateneo Scholarship Program. The responsibility of said institutions is to submit a list of scholars for the school year to the Ministry of Education and Culture for approval of their study leave on official time.
- 6. Nominations for all 14-month scholarship programs which start during the summer of 1980 should reach the MEC Scholarship Committee on or before the third week of February 1980. Fach nomination should be accompanied with the following documents:
 - a. Four copies of the inclosed information sheet duly accomplished by the nominee and certified to by the head of his agency/office or institution.
 - b. The original copy and three (3) photo copies of the nominee's Official Transcript of Records.
 - c. A health certificate duly accomplished by a government physician, including a frog test (to be submitted before enrolment) for married women. There shall be no deferment or maternity leave within the stipulated scholarship period.
 - d. A certified true copy of the nominee's performance rating for the last three years.
 - e. A certificate of clearance from any obligation or pending criminal and/or administrative case by the head of his agency or office.
 - f. A scholarship agreement signed by the nomince, the head of his agency or institution and the regional director under whose jurisdiction his school falls.
 - g. Copies of recent photograph to be attached to the information sheet.

- h. In the case of nominees from private schools, a certification from their schools that all the funding responsibilities will be borne by their respective schools/agencies.
- 7. Selected participants should be advised to take land or sea transportation only.
- 8. It has been observed that for the last three (3) years the field has not sent nominess for the MEC-UF Program for Instructional Supervision, a one-semester non-degree program for school administrators and supervisors in the elementary, secondary and vocational schools. In view of the important rele that supervision plays in educational management, the field is encouraged to send nominess for the aforementioned program in order that their skills in supervision could be enhanced in the different subject areas.
- 9. The field is also informed that the PPSTA Scholarship Program is indefinitely suspended.
- 10. It is desired that this Memorandum and its inclesures be disseminated to all concerned.

THE MEC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

- 1. MEC-UP Communication Arts (English). This program is for teachers, instructors and supervisors of English at the secondary and tertiary levels (public and private). It is designed for the improvement of the teaching and learning of the communication arts in English. The grantees work toward a masteral degree M. Ed. with major in Communication Arts (English).

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 2. MEC-UP Communication Arts (Filipina). This program is for teachers, instructors and supervisors of Pilipina at the secondary and tertiary levels (public and private). It is specifically designed for the improvement of the teaching and lawrning of the communication arts in Pilipina. The grantees work toward a masteral degree M. Ed. with major in Communication Arts (Pilipina).

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 3. MEC-UP Educational Administration This program is open to five (5) supprintendents of schools who shall work toward an Ed. D., major in Educational Administration. It is intended to upgrade/develop skills in the different areas of educational administration especially in policy development and implementation. This scholarship program is offered every two years only, i.e., after the doctoral students shall have completed the two-year period of scholarship granted them.

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 4. MEC-UP Educational Administration This program is open to line and staff administrators of all levels and sectors of the educational system to work towards the M. Ed. major in Educational Administration. It is intended to upgrade/develop skills in the different areas of educational administration especially in policy development and implementation. This scholarship program is for fourteen (44) months. Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 5. MEC-UP Development Program for Instructional Supervision. This is a one semester non-degree program for principals/supervisors of elementary and general secondary schools and vocational instructional supervisors for academic subjects in vocational secondary schools. It is designed to improve supervision of instruction in the different subject areas. This program is effected every semester except summer. Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Mands

- 6. MEC-UP Health France. This program is designed to improve teaching and supervision in Health Education. It is intended for health educators (teachers, instructors, physicians, dentists, nurses, and health coordinators) from general and vocational schools desirous and capable of working a marks a masteral legroe in education with major in Health Education.

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholapskip Funds
- 7. MEC-UP Counsoler Education Program This program sins at improving guidance work at all levers in sectors of the educational system. It is open for those designated as guidance counselers, coordinators and teachers involved in quidance. The grantees are expected to work for a M. EL. degree, major in furdance and Counseling.

 Source of Furding: Mac Scholarship Funds
- 8. MEC-UF Social Studies Fragram This program is designed for the improvement of Social Studies instruction of the educational system both deademic and vocational. It is intended for Social Studies teachers, instructors, department heads and supervisors for Social Studies, who will work towards the masteral degree in Education with major in Social Studies.

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 9. MEC-UP Special Education Teacher Training Program This program is designed to give teachers and uncill any personnel knowledge and skills as well as develop desirable attitudes necessary in working with and in meeting the educational needs of exceptional children and routh. It is offered at the masteral level in the sequences for the gifted, the mentally retarded and those with behavioral problems. This program is for administrators, coordinators, and supervisors of special education who will be trained in Organization, Administration, and Supervisors of Special Education for two (2) surpers with a practical of the (10) weeks following the second summer. This program is finenced from a special fund, (Republic Act No. 5250).
- 10. MEC-UP Educational Technology Program. This grogram is intended for supervisors of educational modia and telephone both academic and vocational who are in charge of audio-visual materials. It is designed to develop additional throulogy accessary for the effectives of educational technology. The grantees are to work for the M.EE. degree in educational technology.

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 11. MEC-TUP Leadership Educational Assistance Program (LEAP) This program is a cooperative educational leadership program in industrial education on the graduate level. It is lesigned to meet the needs of administrators, supervisors, industrial coordinators, and teachers of industrial arts, practical arts, and vocational technic

education. The graduate ocurse and research activities will lead to the completion of the Master of Arts degree in Industrial Education.

Each of the MEC regions shall be allotted at least two (2) slots under this scholarship and the remaining six (6) slots shall be distributed to less developed regions based on needs subject to the approval of the MEC Scholarship Committee provided, however, that unfilled slots shall be awarded to the most deserving scholars from these regions. Of the total thirty (30) slots, the elementary and secondary (public and private) schools shall have ten (10) slots. (Two semesters and one summer) Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds.

- 12. MEC-UP (CLEP) Training Program in Home Economics This is a leadership program intended for supervisors, principals, head teachers and teachers in Home Economics. The program is for two (2) semesters and one (1) summer term, starting this summer. Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 13. MEC-WMSU Scholership Program This is for administrators, supervisors and teachers in the public schools who belong to the nine school divisions in the provinces of Zamboanga del Norte, Zamboanga del Sur; Basilan, Tawi-Tawi, Cotabato, Sulu, and the cities of Dapitan, Zamboanga and Faradian. The scholarship program is allotted fourteen (14) slots, twelve (12) slots for the masteral program and two (2) slots for the doctoral program (Educational Management). Nominoes for the doctoral program should hold the position of schools division superintendent. The duration of the scholarship for the masteral level shall be for two (2) semestors and two (2) summers; and for the doctoral program two (2) years. Nomination for the doctoral program at VMSU shall be made every two years. Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 14. MEC-MSU Teacher Leadership Program This is a leadership training program designed for 26 public school teachers, administrators and supervisors in the Muslim communities: Cotabate (including Cotabate City), Sulu (including Jole), Zamboanga del Sur (including Zamboanga City and Basilan City), Leace del Norte (including Iligen City), Lanae del Sur (including Massewi City) and Palawan. This is made up of undergraduate (two years) and graduate programs (two semesters and one summer) that lead to a bachelor's degree in education and a master's degree in education respectively, starting the first semester of the school year.

 Source of Funding: MSU with scharies of grantees paid by MEC (carried in their respective division Form 7)

- 15. MEC-FIC Communication Arbs-inglish (Language and Reading)
 Scholarship Program This is a yearly training no room for selected teachers of reading and language, and teachers, principals and supervisors of both academic and acceptantal school who will lead in the improvement of the English programs in elementary and ascendary schools. (Two summers and two semesters, starting in summer.) School of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 16. MIC-INC Semmanication (arts-Pilipino (wike at Taghtsa) Scholarship Program This is a yearly training program for selected teachers, supervisors and administrators of both academic and vocational cohools who will provide leadership in improving the Filipino programs in the elementary and secondary schools. (Two summers and two semesters, starting summer.)

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 17. MEC-FNC Educational Management Program This is a yearly training program for selected school administrators and supervisors who will undergo training in effective leadership. (Two summers and two senesters, starting summer.)

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 18. MEC-FNC Training Program for Special and Exceptional Children.—
 This is designed to equip teachers of the blind, the deaf and the mentally gifted with the necessary competencies who will deal with these types of exceptionalities. At least 10 teachers in each area of exceptionality of 30 altogether will undergo two semesters and one summer of training under a special fund created for the purpose.

 Source of Funding: Republic Act 3562
- 19. MEC-FNC Guidance and Counseling Frogram This is a yearly training program for selected elementary grades teachers. This program will acquaint them with the basic philosophy and nature of guidance services and equip them with skills in developing, managing, organizing and supervising the school guidance service. (Two summers and two semesters, starting this summer.)

 Source of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 20. MEC-MIST (BSE) Scholarship Program at the Marikina Institute of Science and Technology This is designed to improve teachers/administrators in Mathematics and Science and in the different Shop Technologies, as well as in the supervision and administration of the three phases of vecational education agriculture, fishery trade and other allied courses. The courses lead to Master of Arts in Teaching (Mathematics/Biology/Chemistry/Physics and in the different Shop Technologies: Machine Shop/Wirls Trades/Drafting/

Automechanics/Electrician/Homemaking Arts/Industrial Arts/ and Haster of Education with major in Administration and Supervision slanted to vocational education. There are 50 slots for the vocational schools and 15 slots for teachers/instructors in science for the general high schools. The course covers two (2) superstars and two (2) summers starting in June. The school provides free tuition fees but miscellaneous fees are paid by the grantees.

Source of Funding: NEO Scholarship Funds

- 21. MEC-146 Physical Education and Sports Development Scholarship Program This program aims to update, upgrade and carried the training of physical education teachers and supervisors. Specifically, this program intends to build up the physical education leaders in the elementary and secondary schools who will work for the masteral and certificate in physical education. Ten (10) slots are provided yearly with PMC providing free tuition and other school foes. The MEC grants the scholar official time, book allowance, monthly stipends and travel expenses from efficial station to Manila and return. This program is for two semesters and two summers.

 School of Funding: MEC Scholarship Funds
- 22. NEC-SIL Scholarship Program for Teachers of ethnic communities for the summer vacation consists of a masteral course in Functional Literacy offered at the Baguio Vacation Normal School wish the assistance of instructors from the Summer Institute of Las quistics in accordance with a Memorandum of Agreement between the ARC and the SIL. Twenty (20) scholarship slots are offered to teachers in ethnic communities to squip them with the tools of Linguistics, grammatical analysis, semantic, phonetics, linguistics for functional literacy teaching and for the production and translation of relevant materials into usable forms by othric o magnities. This program is also designed to have an cutput of trained personnel to serve in educational progrems for the development of othnic communities. The criteria for colecting, the nominees for this particular scholarship grants are similar to those prescribed in this REC Memorgadum. Source of Funding: HEC Scholarchip Funds
- 23. UEC-PSU (Inngacinan State University) Scholarship Program This program is intended for selected trachers, school administrators, supervisors and educational researchers of Megicus I, II, and III who will take up M.A. in Educational Management, M.A. in Science Education and M.A. in Mathematics Education. The CLTC shall provide the scholars the necessary venue, facilities, and book allowance of F150 to be given in three (3) installments until the duration of his scholarship grant. MEC shall grant official

time to the greatees and shall continue to receive their salaries through the IBM shocks. This program is for three (3) semesters and one (1) summer starting in June every school year. Source of Funding: TSU Scholarship Fund

- 24 MEC-DMMRTSC (Don Mariano Marcos Memorial Polytochnic State College) Scholurship Program - This program is designed to develop leadership and management skills emeng school managers and supervisors of vocational-technical education in Mindanae and Sulu area who shall pursue a masteral program (non-thesis) with concentration in Vocational-Technical Education. This program is allotted thirtyfive (35) slots every school year and are distributed as follows: five (5) slots shall come from DMANTEC; eight slots (8) from vocational schools in Mindanao area; cight (8) slots from MEC :regional offices; and nine (9) slots from school divisions in Region X. The DMMTPSC shall provide the scholars monthly stipend of P300; book allowance of P500; tuition and other school fees; travel expenses (boat/land only) from the scholar's station to DMMMPSC and research allowance of F1,000 for the whole term. The MEC grants the scholars official time and they shall therefore; continue to receive their selaries during their masteral studies. This program is for two (2) semesters and one (1) summer term, starting in June of every school year. Source of Funding: DMMMPSC Scholarship Fund
- 25. MEC-Fhilemlire Insurance Scholarship Program This program is for high school teachers and guidance counselors of public and private schools who shall pursue a course leading to the degree of Master of Arts in Education; major in Guidance, at the University of the Philippines, Dilimen, Guezon City. The Philomlife shall provide the scholars 710,700 for the entire course to cover tuition fees, board and lodging, books and school supplies and pocket money; one round trip transportation fare from the scholar's station to the place of residence in Manila, for provincial scholars; and free medical checker and treatment of inter allments at Philamlife medical department. This program is allotted thirteen (13) slots, one (1) slot for each region of the NEC. The NEC shall great scholars from the public high schools official time and they shall continue to receive their salaries during the time of their scholarship term. This scholarship program is for three (3) semesters and one (1) summer term, starting in June of every school your. High school vecchers who are interested in this so clearship program may apply on the Fhilamlife office in their locality. Philamlife Instrumes Scholership Fund Source of Funding:

- 26. MEC-BSE Scholarship Program for Fishery Teachers and Instructors who have only finished the fishery technical curriculum - This program aims to upgrade the competencies of fishery teachers and instructors by allowing them to consinue and finish the 4-year BS in Fisheries in any of the public fishery schools or college offering a 4-year degree course. The program covers a period of three (3) semesters which shall include one (1) semester of on-the-job training. Their respective schools take care of their monthly stipend, book allowance and one round trip transportation expenses (either by land or boat). The amount will depend upon the availability of funds of the school but not to exceed the approved monthly stipend and book allowances set by the MEC as this is not on the graduate level. The slot per year is 25 for the thirteen (13) regions. The need to upgrade the qualifications of fishery teachers and instructors with 22 to 3 years fishery-chemical education allows them to be exempted from the civil service eligibility requirements. Source of Funding: Local school funds with a grant on official time by the MEC
- 27. MEC-CSAT Scholarship Program This program is designed for school administrators, supervisors and teachers from government vocational, technical and fishery schools as well as for supervisory officials from the city and provincial school divisions in the Visayas and Mindanao. This scholarship program is allotted fifty (50) slots and the courses offered are: Master of Arts in Education with major in Administration and Supervision of Vocational Schools (M.ED) or Master of Arts in Vocational Education (M.A.ED.). The institutions and school divisions sponsoring the scholar shall be responsible for the transportation expenses, monthly stipend of not more than F300, and book allowance for one year of the same amount. The MEC shall grant the scholars official time and they shall continue to receive their IBM checks during the period of scholarship. The CSAT shall provide free tuition fees to selected participants. The program is for two (2) scalesters and two (2) summors, starting in summor. Source of Funding: Local school funds with a grant on official time by the MEC
- 28. MEC-Ateneo Scholership Program This program of scholership aims to update, upgrade and enrich the training of guidance counselors and school administrators in Matropolitan Manila. Specifically, this program intends to build up a corps of specialists in the area of educational administration (elementary and high schools), who will work for the Master of Arts in Education degree. This scholarship is allotted five (5) slots. The Ateneo de Manila University provides free tuition to the scholers. The MEC grants

the scholars official time, and they shall continue to receive their IBM checks during the period of scholarship. The program is for the semesters and two summers beginning in summer. Source of Funding: Local school funds with a grant on official time by the MEC

- 29. MEC-BSC (Bukidnen State College) Scholarship Program This program is for teachers, school administrators, supervisors and advectional researchers at the elementary and secondary levels. It is specifically designed for the improvement of the teaching and learning competencies of public school teachers in Mindanao area. Forty (40) elets are provided each year for the graduate program in education, Bukidnen State College will provide the following scholarship privileges to the scholars: (a) tuition and other fees; (b) book allowance; (c) monthly stipend, and (d) travel expenses from official station to Bukidnen and return. The MEC grants the scholars official time, and they shall continue to receive their IBM checks.

 Source of Funding: BSC Scholarship funds with a grant on official time by the MEC
- 30. MEC-LIT Graduate Scholarship Frogram The MEC-LIT (MATSE) Management Assistance Through Service to Mucetion Scholarship Program at the Leyte Institute of Technology, Tacloban City, is a graduate scholarship program designed to stimulate and encourage innovative, productive and functional research, especially in vocationalindustrial education. The program is simed to develop qualified young men whether school administrators, supervisors and teachers in the school system to become effective instruments of development and furthermore improve the quality of instruction and managerial leadership. The courses land to a Masteral Degree in Industrial Education, Master of Arts in Education with the following fields of concentration: Administration and Supervision, Cuidance, Home Deconcinies and Industrial Arts. At least fifty (50) slots every school year are considered, forty five (45) of which are from the Visayas and Mindanae (good for two summers and two (2) semesters starting in April, every summer making a total of fourteen (14) months). The school provides free tuition and miscellaneous fees with no obligation on the part of the grantees. Source of Funding; Local school funds with a grant on official time by the MEC

31. MEG-FMC Scholarship Program for a FM. D. in Bilingual Education → This is a training program designed for selected supervisors and administrators of both academic and vocational schools for the thirteen (13) regions who will take leadership in improving the Bilingual Education Program in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels. This being a doctoral program, the following are the entry requirements: (1) An M.A. in a field of language for language teaching and (2) Must have taken and passed the courses in Introduction to Ceneral Linguistics or its equivalent, Basic Statistics and English for Filipine Standards. The Atenco de Manila University, La Salle University and the Fadlippine Mormal College shall provide faculty and library facilities. The FNC shall provide free tuition fees to the selected participants. This program is good for two years.
