NEW FEATURES OF THE 1979 NCEE RATING CARD

- 1. The 1979 National College Entrance Examination Report Card contains certain features that are designed help admissions officers in assisting the students choose their respective courses. Such features include some personal information as the examinee's intended areas of study, his educational apirations, his favorite subject in high school, and the major language/dialects spoken at his home.
- Another innovation that is anticipated to help admissions officers in a computer output indicating the ranking of 1970 NCEE examinees as to college/university preferred. On the basis of students' NCEE General Scholastic Aptitude Average and the equivalent percentile rank, admissions directors and guidance officers would have a preliminary evaluation of prospective enrolees in their respective institutions and narrow down the choices the apparently most deserving. In this profile, the national, regional, and institution-preferred ranking shall be indicated. For example, if there are 20,000 students opting to enroll and only 4,000 students can be accommodated in a certain institution, then this profile would be valuable in pointing out who among the students could be initially selected.
- 3. Upon request, individual institutions of higher learning may secure the aforementioned computer output from the Ministry of Education and Culture. The National Educational Testing Center shall be ready

to serve interested schools with this computer output at cost, starting on April 30, 1980.

4. It is requested that this Memorandum be brought immediately to the attention of all concerned for their information and guidance.
