1980 SUMMER CLASSES IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION AT THE  
POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors

1. The Institute of Physical Education and Sports of the Polytechnic University of the Philippines will offer a program leading to a Certificate in Physical Education during the summer term of 1980, starting April 14 to May 24, for teachers in both public and private schools and college students majoring in Physical Education.
2. The aims of the program are to assist the government in the attainment of its physical fitness and sports objectives, and to help meet the country's need for trained teachers, sports coaches and recreation leaders in physical education.
3. The maximum load in which summer school students in physical education will be permitted to take is ten units (six theoretical and four practical). Completion of each course will be credited toward the earning of a Certificate in Physical Education for which 40 units will be required. On the reverse side is a list of subjects to be offered.
4. Application for enrolment may be sent to the Director, Institute of Physical Education and Sports, or to the Registrar, Polytechnic University of the Philippines, Sta. Mesa, Metro Manila. Registration period at the campus will start from April 7 to 11, 1980 at 8:00 to 5:00 p.m.

5. Male and female students are required to provide themselves with white T-shirts, maroon shorts and tennis shoes.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
