- 1. Department Order No. 15, s. 1973, entitled "Revised Physical Education and Health, Preparatory Military Training and Scouting Program in Secondary Schools" suggested an integrated approach to the activities for YDT I and CAT I. However, this has not been fully implemented.
- 2. One of the findings of the survey of training needs of teachers conducted by the National Research and Development Center for Teacher Education is the need for a training program for teachers and supervisors in YDT.
- 3. In this connection, the Baguio Vacation Normal School, Peachers Camp, Baguio City, will offer two seminar courses on Integrated YDT-CAT this summer, which will entitle the participant to a certificate, if taken as non-credit, or which may be credited towards the Master of Arts degree major in YDT. The courses offered are:
 - YDT I Overview of the Integrated YDT program:
 A background course which will provide
 an orientation, rationale and objectives
 of the program.
 - YDT II- Practicum: A curriculum and materials development training workshop for the preparation of curriculum framework integrated YDT guides and sample lesson plans.

- 4. Each regional office should send at least four participants, preferably two teachers and two supervisors who are directly in charge of the YDT program in the schools.
- 5. General requirements for enrolment at the BVNS including fees to be charged are given in MEC Memorandum No. 287, s. 1979. Detail regarding board and lodging rates at the Camp are given in MEC Memorandum No. 302, s. 1979.
