SUMMER COURSES FOR MUSIC TEACHERS

- 1. The U.P. Musical Arts and Research Management Foundation, in cooperation with the U.P. College of Music, will conduct the second Summer Courses under the Continuing Education Music Program for teachers from all over the country. The program emphasizes updating of materials and the revitalization of techniques of pedagogy with a general orientation on local music conditions.
- 2. Completion of all course offerings in the entire program (staggered within a 4-summer period) will provide music competence and proficiency particularly useful to teachers and a wider exposure to the various aspects of Philippine musiculture. At the end of the program each participant will earn a Program Certificate. For summer 1980, both the first and second summer courses and other supplementary courses will be offered as per the information contained in the inclosure.

RATIONALE

The Program of Continuing Education for Music Teachers, Professional Musicians and Laymen consists of short-term non-degree courses in various aspects of music and musi• education. It is designed to to meet the developmental needs of individuals engaged in the following areas in music:

- 1. Classroom teaching in the preparatory, elementary and high schools for updated know-ledge of new materials and revitalization of skills and techniques of pedagogy.
- Choral conducting in schools and non-professional ensembles.
- Composition and arranging.
- 4. Theater

Some courses are also intended to benefit the non-professional musicians or music aficionados who are simply interested in expanding their musical horizons.

Completion of all the course offerings of the entire program (staggered within a 4-summber cycle) is meant to provide music competence and proficiency particularly useful to teachers and will earn for the participant a Program Certificate. A Certificate of Attendance will also be issued for each completed course.

Enrolment and payment of fees is done one hour before the first session of the course. However, in some classes where the number of students is limited, advance enrolment is advised. In some others, minimum numbers may be required to start.

All sessions will be held at the Abelardo Hall, u_*P_* College of Music.
