BVNS ARTS COURSES FOR TEACHERS AT THE NATIONAL ARTS CENTER, MAKILING

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. Courses for elementary and secondary arts teachers and supervisors from public and private schools will be offered by the BVNS in cooperation with the Cultural Center of the Philippines for the Arts at the National Arts Center, Mt. Makiling, Los Baños, Laguna on April 4-May 23, 1980.

2. Three 3-unit courses will be offered and these will be credited by BVNS towards the Master of Arts in Education degree.

Education in the Arts:

A background course on the general history and development of music, dance theater and visual arts with special emphasis on Philippine Art and the influences that have played a part in its development.

Teaching the Arts:

A methods course on teaching and learning the arts, covering theories and principles, modern strategies and practicum in the different teaching-learning activities.

Curriculum Development for Arts:

A curriculum and materials development training seminar-workshop on general theories on curriculum development of curriculum frameworks, guides, lessons and self-learning packages.

3. Enrollment will be limited to teachers and supervisors. Those who are directly involved in arts education, communication arts, music education, dance education and YDT may enroll. Registration can be done by mail using the inclosed form. For registration fees, participants will pay the usual BVNS registration fees: Matriculation fee of ₱10; tuition fee of ₱15 per unit and other fees amounting to ₱48. For board and lodging participants will be charged twenty-five (₱25) a day payable upon registration.

4. The expenses shall be from personal funds.
