ADDENDUM TO MEC MEMORANDUM NO. 121, S. 1979

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. In view of the close of the second semester of school year 1979-80 on March 22, the long vacation remains unchanged, i.e., from March 30 to June 7. Therefore, teachers and other school personnel on the teachers leave should render service up to March 28 in order that they may be entitled to the payment of their salaries from March 23 to 29. They should be assigned to perform work usually done in connection with the end of the school year such as helping in the inventory of school equipment and supplies and preparation of their reports and clearances.

2. In computing the 1980 long vacation salaries of teachers, the total number of days from June 10, 1979 to March 29, 1980 including Sundays and holidays (less the 14 days Christmas vacation and absences without pay) should be multiplied by 0.3.

3. Please be guided accordingly.
