To: Bureau Directors Regional Directors Schools Superintendents Presidents, State Colleges and Universities Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- The Ministry of National Defense/Armed Forces of the Philippines and Ministry of Education and Culture will jointly conduct the Cadet/Cadette Officers Leadership Training (COLT) for Volunteer CAT I at the University of the Philippines, Department of Citizen Military Training, Diliman, Quezon City, during the period 1-30, April 1980.
- The objective of the course is to qualify high school student volunteers for commission as Cadet/Cadette Officers in the Cat I Corps, and make them effective assistant instructors for the CAT I program in their schools.
- Training facilities will be provided by the MND/AFP while each trainee will shoulder his/her own expense during the training period.
- Students who are recommended by their school heads to attend this training program will be accepted on a first come, first served basis, provided the allocation of 1,000 trainees will not be exceeded.
- It is desired that this Memorandum be given immediate wide publicity for the information of all concerned.
