CITIZEN ARMY TRAINING INSTRUCTORS COURSE
(CATIC) FOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Administrators/Principals of Secondary Schools

1. The Ministry of National Defense/Armed Forces of the Philippines and the Ministry of Education and Culture will jointly conduct the Citizen Army Training Instructor Course (CATIC) for high school teachers at the University of the Philippines, Quezon City, during the period 1-30, April 1980. This will be a non-live-in training.
2. The objective of the course is to qualify high school teachers to be commandants and instructors for Citizen Army Training (CAT).
3. The course will integrate training for YCAP coordinators in cooperation with the MEC National YCAP Coordinating Center.
4. Training support will be provided by the MND/AFP while transportation and maintenance of trainees will be charged against available local funds.
5. Each region may send to this training thirty-five (35) participants. They will be accepted for such training on a first come, first served basis.
6. It is requested that this MEC Memorandum be given immediate wide publicity.
