XIVTH CONGRESS OF THE INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION FOR HOME ECONOMICS

- 1. The International Federation for Home Economics will hold its 14th Congress on July 21-26, 1980 at the Philippine International Convention Center, Manila.
- 2. The theme of the convention is: "Home Economics: A Responsible Partner in Development." The focus will be on problems involved in development concerning individuals and families in rural and urban areas, such as: (a) Improvement of Health; (b) Management of Resources; and (c) Participation of Women. The role of home economics in communication, formal and nonformal education, planning and policy-making will likewise be discussed.
- 3. The registration fee is one hundred fifty pesos (¥150). This does not include food, social events and tours. Acceptance for attendance will be on a "first come first served" basis.
- 4. Members of the three national home economics associations PHEA, CODHEP and BAEX (HEEAF) will be given first preference. The aforementioned organizations will accept and register their own member applicants.
- 5. In view of the valuable experiences and education benefits which may be derived from attending the convention, home economics supervisors and teachers in public and private schools are enjoined to attend. Attendance is on official time only. All expenses will be personal.
- 6. Immediate dissemination and implementation of this Memorandum is desired.
