MEC-UNESCO SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON SYSTEMS APPROACH FOR
EDUCATION-TEACHER IN-SERVICE PROGRAMME (SAFE TIP)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. A National Seminar-Workshop on Systems Approach for Education-Teacher In-Service Programme (SAFE-TIP) will be conducted by the Bureau of Elementary Education and National Research and Development Centre for Teacher Education, Ministry of Education and Culture in coordination with the United Nations Educational and Scientific Cultural Organization (Unesco, Bangkok) at the La Salette Shrine, Silang, Cavite, from June 2 to June 11, 1980.
2. The seminar-workshop is designed to:
 - a. increase the participant's basic knowledge of the techniques of systems analysis including its philosophy, terminology and processes; and
 - b. develop their skills in applying systems analysis to educational problems at the micro- and macro-levels.
3. The participants in this seminar-workshop will include the thirteen (13) chiefs of the elementary education divisions of the MECRO and the twenty-seven (27) principals from the thirteen (13) regions whose names may be found in the inclosed list. These participants were selected by a screening committee in this Office on the basis of specific criteria for the purpose.
4. Pre-seminar reading materials will be sent each participant for intensive study. Considering the importance of this training program, every participant is enjoined to prepare himself creditably for the interactions during the seminar-workshop.

5. The participants are requested to bring to the workshop the following:

- a. A list of five (5) problems specific to the participants' region/division associated with in-service training of teachers categorized on priority order. It is expected that this list will be developed through consultations and discussions with groups of resource persons; and
- b. A case study for each of the first three problems describing each problem situation and analyzing the variables or factors that effect each situation.

6. Funding for this seminar-workshop will be provided by **Unesco**. Other details regarding travel, per diems, and living allowances will be given in a forthcoming memorandum.
