ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR THE SCHOOL  
SAFETY PATROL PROGRAM

To Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges  
and Universities

1. To implement a more uniform and effective School Safety Patrol Program nationwide, the following guidelines are hereby issued in addition to those provided in MEC Memorandums Nos. 94 and 105, s 1979:

- a Each school in urban and semi-urban areas where vehicular traffic is heavy and/or hazardous must be encouraged to form a School Safety Council. This Council, to be composed of the school head as chairman, a designated Patrol Supervisor (preferably PE/CAT or Health teacher), a PTA officer, and a student representative as members, will sanction the operation of the School Safety Patrol and look after the safety of its members,
- b On the district level, a District Safety Committee may be organized composed of the district supervisor as Chairman, all designated Patrol Teacher-Supervisors in the district, and a representative from the Safety Education Service as members. This committee will help formulate policies, observe and review operations of the School Safety Patrols within the district
- c On the regional level, a regional safety coordinator should be designated by the Regional Director, with the duty of, among others, seeing to it that the Safety Committee in the districts and the Safety Councils in the schools are organized and are performing whatever is necessary

in the attainment of an effective and more or less uniform Safety Patrol Program in the region.

2. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought immediately to the attention of all concerned.
