ENCOURAGING VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOLS PARTICIPATION
IN THE CB-MEC SUPERVISED EXPERIENCE EDUCATION PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. In support of the national efforts for increased productivity vocational technical schools other than those indicated in MEC Memorandum No. 56, s. 1980, are encouraged to participate in the CB-MEC Supervised Experience Education Program.
2. In accordance with the guidelines enumerated in the aforementioned Memorandum students in vocational technical schools shall submit their project proposals for funding based on the profitability of the enterprise as determined jointly by the school and the rural bank.
3. The project proposal shall be prepared in accordance with the requirements of rural banks and on the forms used in bank transactions.
4. The project proposal, together with supporting papers, shall be forwarded in quadruplicate for appraisal to:

5. The CB-MEC Management Committee shall, on the basis of its appraisal of the project proposal, recommend the inclusion of such vocational technical schools on the accredited list upon approval of the Ministry of Education and Culture.
6. Schools accredited under this Program shall be notified accordingly.

7. It is desired that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity for the information of all concerned.
