1980 ALAY TANIM CONTEST

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Vocational School Superintendents/  
Administrators

1. The Fifth National Alay Tanim Contest will be conducted from June 9, 1980 to March 31, 1981.
2. The contest this school year highlights Phase V of the implementation of LOIs Nos. 586 and 872(6) or Alay Tanim Program which has been expanded to include the closely related School Health Guardian Program (SHGP) embodied in LOI No. 764. Phase V seeks to strengthen further the implementation and integration of all programs/projects of the School Health and Nutrition Center under the umbrella of the School Health Guardian Program, namely: (a) Alay Tanim, Division Orchard Development, Food Production, Supplementary Feeding, Nutrition Education, Health Services, Environmental Sanitation, Research Studies and Uses of Medicinal Plants, in all the divisions of the 13 regions. Private schools may be included.
3. A Bagong Lipunan building will be awarded to each regional winner receiving the highest point in the implementation of LOIs Nos. 586, 764 and 872(6) for national agricultural schools. It is therefore requested that each region select three (3) divisions as entries for the best implementor of these integrated programs/projects. For the winners of LOIs Nos. 586 and 764 contests, separate prizes for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places will be given. Each division should select 10 outstanding schools for the integrated School Health Guardian Program award. Entries should be submitted before September 30, 1980 to the National Evaluation Committee, MEC, Manila, Attention: Assistant Secretary Vedasto G. Suarez. The evaluation of national winners will

start October 15, 1980 to enable this Office to make the announcement of regional and national winners during the first week of December 1980.

4. Division/regional evaluation of entries should be a continuing and progressive process. The contests should start among schools within the district, among districts within the division and finally among divisions within the region.

5. The guidelines for the implementation of LOIs Nos. 586, 764 and 872(6), which should be used as bases for the selection of regional/national winners, are inclosed.

6. Likewise inclosed for ready reference is the list of names of officials to compose the evaluation teams.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

1. Division/regional model orchards and Alay Tanim project ..... 30 points
  - a. Number of fruit trees planted and living, June to December 1980
  - b. Number of fruit, forest, ornamental trees (1976-1979)
  - c. Degree of implementation of the division orchard development plan
  - d. Number of orchard projects within the division
  - e. Submission of 1979 consolidated regional Alay Tanim report
  - f. Water and soil conservation
  - g. School campus beautification and landscaping
2. Nutrition ..... 10 points
  - a. Supplementary feeding - utilization of indigenous foods
  - b. Selective food production - planting of priority crops
3. Medicinal Plants ..... 20 points
  - a. Number and variety of medicinal plants being cultured within the division
  - b. Studies/researches on medicinal plants including such items as uses, parts used, preparation, dosage, etc.
  - c. Consolidated reports/album/scrapbook
  - d. Actual use of medicinal plants in treating common ailments in the school and community

  - c. Accurate record keeping of height and weight, treatment, etc.
  - d. Evidence of guidance/physical examination/treatment among pupils
- 5. Integration of Health and Nutrition Education in Curricular Offering ..... 10 points
- 6. Environmental Sanitation ..... 10 points
  - a. Proper waste and garbage disposal
  - b. Recycling of waste materials
  - c. Drainage and sewerage system
- 7. Community Involvement in School Health Guardian Programs ..... 10 points
