MEC-NFE SURVEY ON ILLITERATES AND SEMI-LITERATES
IN EVERY BARANGAY

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents.

1. In view of the continuing concern for the eradication of illiteracy in all countries of the world, and pursuant to the recommendations and declaration of MINEDASO IV on regional cooperation in education in Asia and Oceania, the Office of Nonformal Education, Ministry of Education and Culture will undertake an intensive survey to determine the extent of illiteracy in the country as a basis for developing a literacy program for the biennium 1980-1982.
2. The objective of the survey is to gather complete data on the total number of illiterates and semi-literates in every barangay. The results of the survey will be utilized mainly for planning and organizing literacy classes in the areas where they are needed.
3. All district nonformal education coordinators are requested to undertake the survey in all the barangays in their respective areas. Inclosed is the form to be used in the survey. The completed form must be submitted to the Office of Nonformal Education, Ministry of Education and Culture on or before September 30, 1980.
4. Transportation expenses in the amount of one hundred pesos (P100) will be given to each district NFE coordinator for the conduct of the survey.
5. It is desired that dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned be done immediately.

FORM FOR THE SURVEY ON ILLITERATES AND
SEMI-LITERATES IN EVERY BARANGAY

Instructions for District NFE Coordinator:

1. The purpose of this survey is to determine the total number of illiterates and semi-literates in every barangay in the district.
2. An illiterate person in this context is one who cannot read and write, while a semi-literate person is one who may have finished Grade III but has forgotten most of his literacy skills. These two categories of persons will be included in the survey.
3. The result of the survey will be utilized mainly for planning and organizing literacy classes in the areas where they are needed.
4. The survey should be personally conducted by the District NFE Coordinator using the form on the reverse side.
