To: Bureau Directors Regional Directors Schools Superintendents Presidents, State Colleges and Universities Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- 1. MEC Memorandum No. 56, s. 1979 entitled "Up-dated Policies on the National College Entrance Examination" states that passing the NCEE is not required of students from the School for the Deaf and the Blind.
- 2. Effective immediately, this privilege will extend to all deaf or blind students graduating from the secondary level in special schools, public and private, and vocational schools.
- A certificate of exemption can be obtained from the NETC Office upon presentation of a certificate from the head/principal of the school where he/she graduated or is graduating duly approved by the city/provincial superintendent of schools.
- It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated immediately.
