EXEMPTION OF PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED  
FROM TAKING THE NCEE

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and  
Universities

1. MEC Memorandum No. 56, s. 1979 entitled "Updated Policies on the National College Entrance Examination" states that passing the NCEE is not required of students from the School for the Deaf and the Blind.

2. Effective immediately, this privilege will extend to all deaf or blind students graduating from the secondary level in special schools, public and private, and vocational schools.

3. A certificate of exemption can be obtained from the NETC Office upon presentation of a certificate from the head/principal of the school where he/she graduated or is graduating duly approved by the city/provincial superintendent of schools.

4. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated immediately.
