WORK-CONFERENCES ON THE SCHOOL HEALTH GUARDIAN PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors Regional Directors Schools Superintendents

- 1. A series of 4-day work-conferences in all regions will be conducted by the School Health and Nutrition Center (SHNC) in coordination with the inter-agency Task Force in the implementation of LOI No. 1023. The theme of the work-conferences is "Towards a Balanced Physical and Mental Health, Intellectual and Socio-Economic Development of the Child."
- 2. The objectives of the work-conferences are to:
 - a. implement an integrated action plan for the School Health Guardian Program (SHGP); and
 - b. plan with the district supervisors a scheme for the implementation of LOI No. 1023, "Additional Compensation to Public School Teachers for Participation in Priority Programs of the Government."
- 5. During the work-conferences, the participants are expected to:
 - delineate duties and responsibilities of each personnel involved in the SHGP;
 - b. evolve an integrated action program;
 - c. design a simple monitoring system; and
 - d. plan a scheme for the implementation of LOI No. 1023.
- 4. The participants shall be composed of regional and division supervisors/coordinators involved in the SHGP. The following participants will come from the regional offices:
 - a. General Education Supervisor (GES) for Elementary Agriculture/Alay Tanim Coordinator;

- b. GES for Nutrition;
- c. Supplementary Feeding Coordinator (CARE/CRS/WFP);
- d. GES for Health (from Elementary Education Division if there are two GES for Health);
- e. Medical Services Supervisor/Senior Clinic Physician or Supervising Dentist/Senior Dentist in the absence of a physician.

The following participants will come from each division:

- a. GES for Elementary Agriculture/Alay Tanim coordinator;
- b. GES for Nutrition/ANP-H.E.;
- Supplementary Feeding Coordinator (CARE/CRS/WFP);
- d. GES for Health; and
- e. Division Medical Officer or Dental Supervisor in the absence of a physician.
- 5. The Regional Directors are requested to make arrangements for the venue and other needs pertaining to the work-conference.
- 6. The participants shall bring along the following:
 - Regional and division consolidated reports of the SHGP evaluation;
 - Action program for each SHGP project for SY 1979-80 and 1980-81;
 - List of schools by districts with latest enrolment;
 - d. List of teachers by district;
 - Updated list of CARE/CRS participating schools with present number of beneficiaries;
 - f. Copy of "Summary Report on the Nutritional Status of Public Elementary School Children";
 - g. Distribution lists of teaching guides/unit texts focused on nutrition and of height and weight charts;
 - h. Status report of regional SHGP pilot schools; and
 - i. All required reports due for submission.

These will serve as bases in the discussion of the status of SHGP projects.

- 7. In addition, the WFP regional and division project coordinators will bring the upgraded list of participating schools with corresponding number of participants based on the approved reorientation plan; schedule of supervision of SY 1979-80 and 1980-81; status of construction of water system/garden structures and installation of jotmatic pumps.
- 8. The participants are entitled to collect transportation expenses and per diems subject to existing accounting and auditing regulations. (COA General Circular No. 127 dated November 27, 1973)
- $9 \, \bullet \,$ Inclosed are the schedule of the work-conferences and the tentative program of sctivities.
- 10. It is desired that the content of this Memorandum be immediately disseminated to all concerned.
