IMPLEMENTATION OF SYSTEMS APPROACH FOR EDUCATION-TEACHER
IN-SERVICE PROGRAM (SAFE-TIP) IN THE FIELD

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. A national seminar-workshop on Systems Approach for Education-Teacher In-Service Program (SAFE-TIP) was held at the La Salette Shrine, Silang, Cavite on June 2-11, 1980. This seminar-workshop was designed to increase the participants' basic knowledge of the techniques of systems analysis and develop their skills in applying systems analysis to educational problems. This was jointly conducted by the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) and the National Research and Development Center for Teacher Education (NRDCTE) in coordination with the United Nations Educational and Scientific Cultural Organization (UNESCO, Bangkok).
2. Among the outputs of this seminar-workshop were work plans for the macro (regional) and micro (division and school) level implementation of SAFE-TIP.
3. A commitment of the participants in this seminar-workshop (chiefs of the elementary education divisions and two principals from each of the thirteen (13) regions, was a follow-up action on the use of systems approach in the solution of educational problems.
4. In view of this commitment, it is enjoined that all work plans developed during the said seminar-workshop be implemented as a continuing program for the in-service training of principals and other school personnel.

5. It is requested that the MEC (Attention: Staff Development Division, BEE) be furnished a copy of an annual report on the implementation of this program.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought immediately to the attention of all concerned.
